

**SUBJECT:** **10-FOOT WIDTH RESTRICTION – US95 MP 2 TO MP 54 NB & SB – OR/ID BORDER TO ROME**

Beginning on October 7, 2012, US95 from MP 2 near the Idaho border to MP 54 near Rome will be restricted to loads no greater than 10 feet 00 inches in width seven days a week between 8 PM & 8 AM for bridge work.

In addition, this section of highway will be restricted to loads no greater than 14 feet 00 inches in width on Saturday, Sunday, and Monday between the hours of 8 AM & 8 PM. Mobile homes with eaves are allowed providing the base width does not exceed 14 feet 00 inches in width.

Note: Work will be occurring seven days a week at all hours; however oversize loads will be accommodated outside of the restricted days/hours listed above (with potential small delays). The estimated completion date for this work is November 13, 2012.



**Detour Route:**

Loads exceeding these dimensions will need to avoid this area during restricted times, or use alternate authorized routes (refer to the annual permit for routes).

Motor Carriers need to provide this information to their drivers, by copy of this letter or other means, to assure their awareness of the restriction.
