SUBJECT: **16 FT WIDTH RESTRICTION and MULTIPLE INTERMITTENT RAMP CLOSURES:
I-205 NB & SB between MP 13.45 (82nd Ave) and MP 17.80 (Woodstock Rd)**

On June 20, 2012, I-205 northbound and southbound between MP 13.45 (crossing under 82nd Ave) and MP 17.80 (crossing over Woodstock Rd) will be restricted to 16 feet 00 in. in width between the hours of 9 PM & 6 AM Monday through Friday and between the hours on 9 PM and 9 AM Saturday and Sunday. The height will be restricted to 17 feet 00 in. during the same time restricted hours.

In addition, the following ramps will be intermittently closed throughout the duration of the project, to allow for paving work:

- On-ramp from Lawnfield Rd / 82nd Ave to northbound I-205
- I-205 Northbound Exit 14 ramp to Sunnyside Rd / Sunnybrook Blvd
- On-ramp from Sunnybrook Blvd to northbound I-205
- On-ramp from Sunnyside Rd to northbound I-205
- Northbound I-205 Exit 16 to Johnson Creek Blvd
- On-ramp from Johnson Creek Blvd to southbound I-205
- I-205 southbound Exit 14 ramp to Sunnyside Rd / Sunnybrook Blvd
- On-ramp from Sunnyside Rd to southbound I-205
- On-ramp from Sunnybrook Blvd to southbound I-205
- I-205 southbound Exit 13 to OR224 Westbound / Milwaukie

These restrictions are necessary to facilitate asphalt grinding and paving of the mainline freeway and ramps, and installation of a cable median barrier. Estimated date of completion is October 31, 2012

Detour Routes:

Loads or vehicles over 16 feet wide or over 17 feet high should use this section of I-205 during daylight, unrestricted hours.

Lawnfield Rd / 82nd Ave on-ramp to NB I-205: use SB 82nd Dr to WB OR212/OR224, to NB I-205.

I-205 NB Exit 14 to Sunnyside Rd / Sunnybrook Blvd: traffic should continue northbound on I-205 to Exit 16 (Johnson Creek Blvd), cross over the freeway to re-enter I-205 SB, and take Exit 14.

Sunnybrook Blvd on-ramp to NB I-205: traffic should continue northbound on state connector roads and enter NB I-205 from Sunnyside Rd.

Sunnyside Rd on-ramp to NB I-205: traffic should cross over I-205, use the southbound state connector to Sunnybrook Blvd, cross over I-205 and enter NB I-205.

NB I-205 Exit 16 to Johnson Creek Blvd: traffic should continue northbound on I-205, take Exit 17 to Foster Rd, cross under the freeway to re-enter I-205 SB, and take Exit 16.


Johnson Creek Blvd on-ramp to SB I-205 is closed, traffic should cross over the freeway to enter I-205 NB, take Exit 17 to Foster Rd, cross under the freeway and re-enter I-205 SB.

I-205 SB Exit 14 to Sunnyside Rd / Sunnybrook Blvd: traffic should continue south on I-205 to Exit 13, to OR224 WB to OR213 (82nd Ave) northbound to Sunnyside Rd / Sunnybrook Blvd.

Sunnyside Rd on-ramp to SB I-205: traffic should continue south on the state connector to Sunnybrook Blvd, to I-205 SB.

Sunnybrook Blvd on-ramp to SB I-205: traffic should cross over I-205 to the northbound state connector, to Sunnyside Rd, cross over the freeway and enter I-205 SB.

I-205 SB Exit 13 to OR224 Westbound / Milwaukie: traffic should continue south on I-205 to Exit 12A to OR212/OR224, cross over the freeway and re-enter I-205 NB, take Exit 13.
