- » ATTENDEES: Dennis Scofield (ODOT), Chad Brady (ODOT), Michael Leierer (WSDOT), Dick Bolen (METRO), Mike Engelmann (UofO), Bob Denouden (LCOG) and others.
- » ACTION LOG: It was agreed to continue tracking T-FIT work using the Action Log currently in place. The log will be updated to reflect current work being done.
- » WA-TRANS/POOLED FUND PROJECT: The states that are currently giving support are ODOT, Tennessee, Ohio and Nebraska. Solicitations end on July 1, 2006.
- » WASCO PILOT PROJECT: A list of reporting requirements for the county and a list of expectations will be developed for the pilot.

STATUS OF COUNTY EFFORTS: BLM has finished its work on county data development. U of O has completed their work on county data development. Work will begin on assigning and verifying county road number and milepoint information on county datasets.

- » MAINTENANCE OUTLINE: Dennis reported that the outline is almost complete and ready for publication. Flow chart and maps are being sent out for review and comments.
- » DEMONSTRATION: Michael Leierer from WSDOT demonstrated the function of Feature Manipulation Engine (FME) and discussed how it could be used in the role for data custodians to submit data to a centralized database.
