- » ATTENDEES: Dennis Scofield (ODOT), Chad Brady (ODOT), Shannon Marheine (OEM), Gillien Duvall (OEM) Gail Ewart (DAS), Shirley Semour (GeoSolve), Jim Clark (GeoSolve), Bob Pinotti (Polk Co.), Mike Engelmann (UofO), Warren Roe (LCOG) and others.
- » ACTION LOG: The action log will be updated for the next T-FIT meeting.
- » DATA SHARING: Gail reported that while the licensing effort was successful in getting a good number of counties to sign on, it fell short of comprehensively getting everyone included and that the logistics of a single license for every county was just not reasonable. DAS is now looking at partnership opportunities with local data providers.
- » WA-TRANS/POOLED FUND PROJECT: Tami or Michael were not able to attend so Chad gave a brief update on the status. The presentation of the FME software was well received. ODOT will look at evaluating and purchasing the software for the OR-Trans effort.
- » WASCO PILOT PROJECT: A list of reporting requirements for the county and a list of expectations have been developed and we will set up a meeting with Wasco County representatives.
- » STATUS OF COUNTY EFFORTS: Both the BLM and the UofO have finished their contracts for county road centerline creation. ODOT has hired a contractor to verify and assign county road number and milepoints to county datasets.
- » TRANSPORTATION STANDARD: The current transportation standard will be updated with some new fields and will be aired w/ the T-FIT community for comments before the December Standards Forum. Gail mentioned the need to start using standardized terms across the standards for each framework layer.
