SUBJECT: Technical Correction to the Oregon Highway Plan

We are requesting your approval of a technical correction to an STA classification in the 1999 Oregon Highway Plan under the authority delegated to the Director by the Transportation Commission in Delegation Order 2(4).

Due to a recent jurisdictional transfer with the City of Silverton, some of the highway mile points that identify the STA (Special Transportation Area) have changed. The attached map shows roadways involved in the jurisdictional transfer. The attached spreadsheet shows the descriptions of both the previous and the new route.

We have on file a copy of a letter from the City that assumes that the highway mile points associated with the STA would change once the jurisdictional transfer is completed. Therefore the OHP's Registry of Highway Plan Amendments needs to be corrected to reflect the changes in the mile points.

By your signature, the following technical correction is hereby made to the STA classifications that the Oregon Transportation Commission has adopted as part of the 1999 Oregon Highway Plan (changes are in **bold**):

Region 2

1. *Change* OR214 (Highway 140), Hillsboro – Silverton Highway, Roadway 1, endpoint *from* MP 50.66 to **MP 50.72**. The change takes into consideration the segment of C Street and N. Water Street that is now part of OR214 and the STA. The Roadway 2 segment of OR214 is unchanged (MP 50.24 to MP 50.64 on First Street and Lewis Street).
