It is intended to add to the discussion of improving traveler awareness of their surroundings and learning due caution.
152-153	Added definitions for motorcycle, motorcyclist, etc.	Motorcycle safety advocate noted we did not have any motorcycle related definitions, and distinguishing between drivers, passengers, etc. supports a better understanding of motorcycle crash data.
