Project Description: The project will include a number of safety improvements that are undefined at this point, pending further scoping. This corridor has experienced an unusually large number of accidents, including head-on collisions. The solutions may include widening of the median, a median barrier, left turn channelization, centerline rumble strips, warning signs, and restriping of wider shoulder areas to provide more median.

Project Eligibility: The project is consistent with the Clackamas County Rural TSP and the OHP Policy 1G (Major Improvements). It will improve the safety and efficiency of an existing highway. A transit feasibility study found low ridership share forecast even with subsidy.

Project Prioritization: Project design and construction can be accomplished within the proposed 2006-2009 STIP timeline. The project supports the following policies of the OHP: 1A, 1C, 1G, 2D, 2F, 3B, 4A, and 5A. The project would benefit the public through reducing the high rate of fatal collisions.
