

BLITZ ACTIVITIES SCHEDULE

August 30 – September 12, 2010

Week of Aug 22 **Conduct safety belt observed use surveys** in same locations where your enforcement is planned.

Initiate news media contacts to tell public what blitz is about (press releases, radio/TV interviews, schedule ride-alongs, etc.). **See enclosed “Press Points” sheet.**

Aug 30 – Sept 12 **CONDUCT 2 - WEEK ENFORCEMENT BLITZ**
Mon thru Sun *Emphasis: Child Restraints & Fitting Station Referrals*

Sept 19 – 25 *Child Passenger Safety Week (nationwide)*
Sept 25 *“Seat Check Saturday” (nationwide)*

Week of Sept 19 **Conduct safety belt observed use surveys** in same locations as pre-blitz surveys.

Provide information to local news media on Blitz results. Include observations regarding compliance with restraint laws, local use rate changes, number & types of citations written, anecdotal information such as belt use in recent, local crashes, enforcement efforts resulting in lives saved.

As soon as you are able to compile blitz results - Complete and send Blitz Report to your project director (at OSP, OSSA or OACP); check with your project director for any deadline they may be imposing. Note any special activities you performed beyond the basic grant requirements (media ride-alongs, events, child seat clinics, “spotter” or night time enforcement, etc)
