Going back to school has never been easier for Oregon veterans. If you are **not currently receiving federal educational benefits** under any federal act, you may qualify for this program offered exclusively by the Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs. Full-time students can receive up to \$150 per month of attendance or \$100 per month for part-time. To qualify, you must establish eligibility with ODVA then apply for the program benefits. ## ESTABLISHING ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Oregon Veteran Educational Aid Program you must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Active Duty in the U.S. Armed Forces for not less than 90 days; and
- 2) Separated from service under honorable conditions; and
- 3) Provide proof of Oregon residency; and
- 4) Be a citizen of the United States; and
- 5) Served either during the Korean War (June 25, 1950 through January 31, 1955) or after June 30, 1958.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

Complete an **Eligibility Form** (Form 1004-ME) and submit to ODVA along with a **certified copy** of your DD214, showing length and character of service.

After your eligibility has been established, complete the **Application for Oregon Veterans Educational Aid Form** (Form 1005-ME) and submit to ODVA.
