

Healthcare for All Oregon's Children Safety Net Capacity Grant Program

The Safety Net Capacity Grant Program is intended to ensure that children who meet the criteria for Health Care for All Oregon's Children, but are categorically ineligible, have access to primary physical, oral, mental/behavioral and vision healthcare services.

Grantees include community sponsored clinics and school based health centers across both rural and more urbanized areas of the state. OHPR provides technical assistance to grantees regarding both reporting and meeting expected outcomes of the grants.
