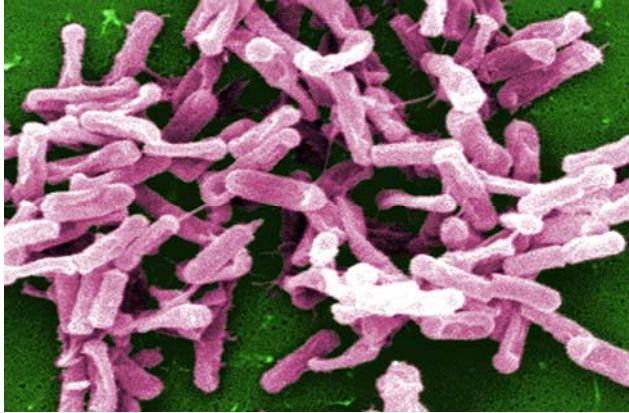

Background

A healthcare acquired infection (HAI) is an infection that occurs during or after treatment for a separate medical condition. In the United States, an estimated 1.7 to 2 million people per year develop an HAI, and nearly 100,000 die.¹ The economic burden of HAIs is substantial, estimated at \$33 billion per year in US hospitals.²

In response to the importance of HAIs, the Oregon state legislature passed House Bill 2524 in 2007 to create a mandatory HAI Reporting Program in an effort to raise awareness, to promote transparency for healthcare consumers and to motivate hospitals to prioritize prevention. HB 2524 assigned responsibility for the HAI Reporting Program to the Office for Oregon Health Policy and Research (OHPR), part of the Oregon Health Authority (OHA), and also created a 16 member committee to advise OHPR on the HAI reporting program.

This research brief focuses on three HAIs:

- ◆ Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSI) are primary

bloodstream infections that are associated with the presence of a central line or a tube that is placed into a patient's large vein, usually in the neck, chest, arm or groin.

- ◆ Surgical Site Infections (SSIs) are infections that are directly related to an operative procedure. The procedures reported in this update are coronary artery bypass graft and knee prosthesis (replacement).
 - Coronary artery bypass graft (CABG) surgery is a treatment for heart disease in which a vein or artery from another part of the body is used to create an alternate path for blood to flow to the heart, bypassing a blocked artery.
 - Knee prosthesis (KPRO) procedures include replacement procedures, replacement of all or part of the knee joint with an artificial device, and revisions of existing prostheses.

Methods

CLABSI and SSI data were collected using the National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN), a free, secure, internet-based HAI surveillance system developed, administered, and maintained by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The system integrates patient and healthcare personnel safety surveillance information from facilities across the nation. The Surgical Care Improvement Project (SCIP) process of care measures were collected according to

protocols established by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). The majority of hospitals (48) reported their data to CMS and OHPR obtained these data from the Hospital Compare web site.

Hospital Review

Copies of data extracted from NHSN and CMS Hospital Compare were sent to the hospital chief executive officer and to the infection control professional. Hospitals were given 30 days to preview and correct their HAI data before publication. This process was vital to assure that the reported data were as accurate as possible. It is noteworthy that several hospitals corrected their data to include more infections.

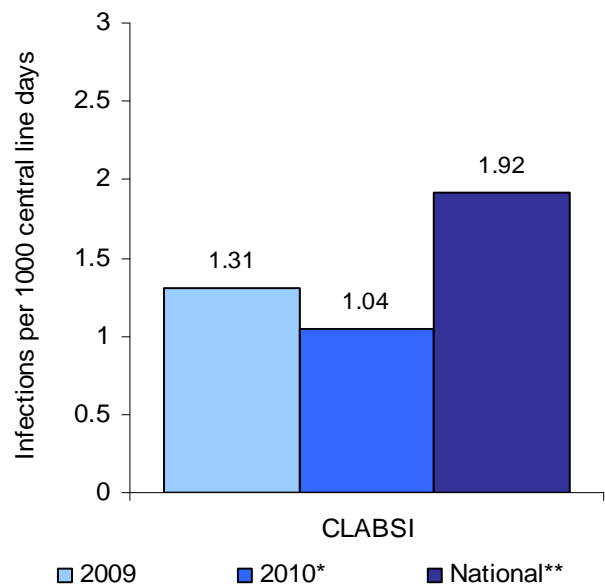
During the hospital review period, two-thirds of Oregon hospitals provided over 60 corrections and/or comments to OHPR regarding their HAI data. OHPR confirmed all corrections with hospitals via email. In addition, one hospital reported it performed a specialty surgery that involved replacement of the knee joint as part of a highly specialized oncologic limb salvage procedure. The hospital flagged these procedures in NHSN and OHPR excluded them from the final reporting data set.

To assure a fair and representative set of data, OHPR applied NHSN minimum reporting thresholds for reporting hospital-level data. The reporting threshold for CLABSIs is a minimum of 50 central line days per reporting period. The reporting threshold for surgical site procedures is a minimum of 20 patients undergoing a surgical procedure per reporting period.

Results

Oregon's statewide CLABSI rate in 2009 was one-third lower than the corresponding national rate (Figure 1). The CLABSI rate for the first six months of 2010 is approximately half of the national rate and about 21% lower than 2009.

Results (continued)

Oregon's statewide KPRO SSI rate in 2009 was essentially the same as the corresponding national rate (Figure 2). The KPRO SSI rate for the first 6 months of 2010 is about one-third lower than the 2009 rate. The highest KPRO SSI rates were reported by hospitals with fifty or fewer beds.

Oregon's statewide CABG SSI rate in 2009 was about 25% lower than the corresponding national rate (Figure 3). The CABG SSI rate for the first 6 months of 2010 is about 11% higher than the 2009 rate, but is still 18% lower than the national rate.

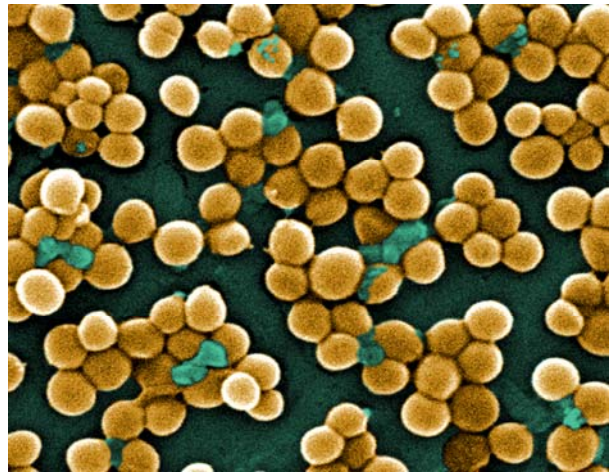
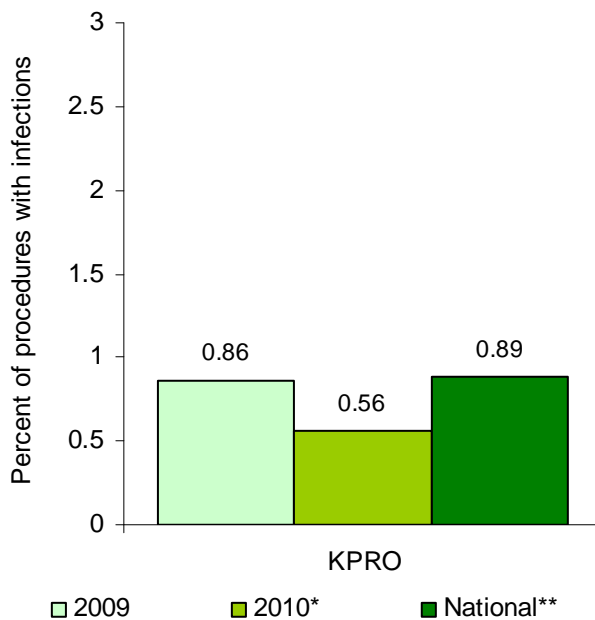


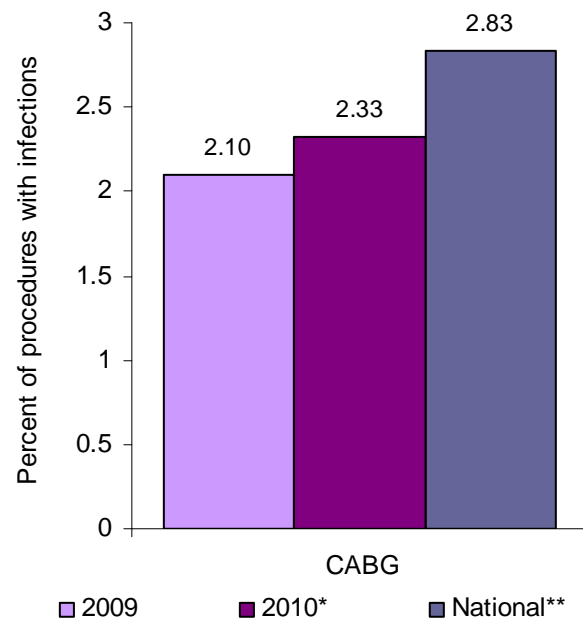

Figure 3: Coronary Artery Bypass Graft (CABG) Surgical Site Infections



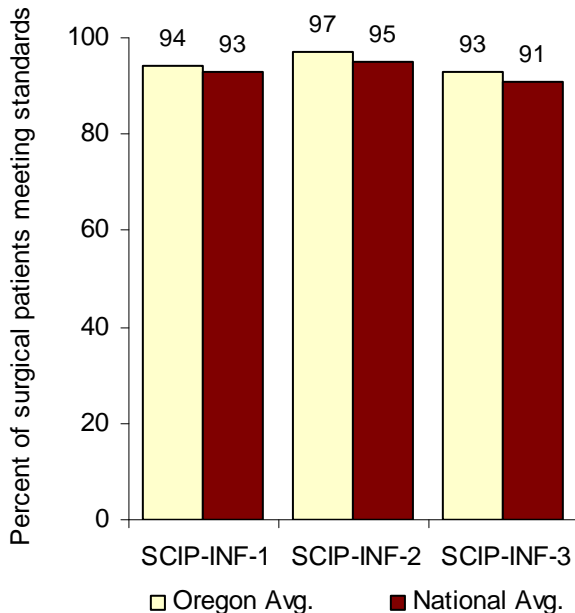

The Surgical Care Improvement Project (SCIP) process of care measures reported here are:

- ◆ SCIP-INF-1: Percent of surgery patients who were given an antibiotic at the right time (within one hour) before surgery to prevent infection.
- ◆ SCIP-INF-2: Percent of surgery patients who were given the right kind of antibiotic to help prevent infection.
- ◆ SCIP-INF-3: Percent of surgery patients whose preventative antibiotics were stopped at the right time (within 24 hours after surgery; 48 hours for cardiac patients).

The statewide averages for SCIP measures were essentially the same as the national averages for these process of care measures (Figure 4).

Discussion

Since the inception of HAI public reporting in 2009, Oregon hospitals overall have consistently reported lower rates of HAIs compared to the most recently published nationwide rates. In particular, the statewide CLABSI rate for the first six months of 2010 is approximately half of the most recent national rate and substantially lower than the 2009 statewide CLABSI rate. Much of this is driven by the 33 hospitals that reported zero CLABSIs during the first six months of 2010.

The KPRO SSI rate for the first six months of 2010 was also substantially lower than the 2009 rate and is about 40% lower than the most recent national rate. Since KPRO SSI cases may be identified for up to one year after the procedure, the KPRO SSI rate for the 2010 calendar year is likely to be higher than the six-month rate.

While the statewide CABG SSI rate for the first six months of 2010 is substantially lower than the most recent national rate, it is about 11% higher than the statewide CABG SSI rate for 2009. CABG SSI cases may also be identified up to one year after the procedure, so the CABG SSI rate for the 2010 calendar year is also likely to be higher than the six-month rate.

Results for 2009 in this Update may differ slightly from the results originally published in the 2009 *Oregon Healthcare Acquired Infections* report in May 2010. Additional CLABSI and SSI cases have been identified since the 2009 report was published. The OHA has begun a project to validate the CLABSI data, and this work has led to identifying a small number of previously unreported CLABSI cases. Additional SSI cases have been identified by hospitals through their routine surveillance. This was

identified up to nine months after the patient was discharged from the hospital.

Limitations

The data reported here are subject to two important limitations:

1. Data are self-reported by the hospital.
2. Surveillance methods and infection control resources vary across hospitals, which may affect a hospital's ability to detect HAI cases. Higher HAI rates may be due to improved case-finding rather than more true HAI cases.

Implications for the Future

OHPR is currently collecting additional HAI data for public reporting and is working to expand the HAI public reporting program. Additional data that will be reported includes healthcare worker influenza vaccination rates for hospitals and nursing homes, urinary tract infection rates for nursing homes, and evidence-based elements of patient safety practices used by ambulatory surgical centers.

In January 2011, hospitals will begin reporting four additional surgical site infections, including abdominal hysterectomy, colon surgeries, hip replacements, and laminectomies.

Hospitals will also begin reporting two additional process of care measurements for cardiac surgery with controlled postoperative glucose and surgery patients with peri-operative temperature management. OHPR will evaluate HAI reporting in other health care facilities.

The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act includes a hospital value-based purchasing program for HAIs, which includes federal reporting of HAIs for hospitals and adjusting Medicare reimbursement rates based on performance. This will require many Oregon hospitals to expand CLABSI reporting in 2011 and may also require expanded SSI reporting in 2012.

Hospital HAI Data Sheets

As part of this report, OHPR has prepared individual HAI data sheets for the 58 acute care hospitals in Oregon. These HAI data sheets present summary data and two columns of graphs, with the 2009 data presented on the left side of the page and the January through June 2010 data presented on the right. In the spring of 2011, OHPR plans to update this report to compare HAI data for the entire calendar years of 2009 and 2010.

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Healthcare Acquired Infection Reporting Program

Hospital Comments on HAI Data Sheets

During their 30-day review of the hospital-level Healthcare Acquired Infection (HAI) reports, all hospitals were also given the opportunity to provide comments on their reports. Five hospitals provided comments on their HAI data reports, and they are listed in alphabetical order.

- Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center
- Mercy Medical Center
- Oregon Health and Science University (OHSU) Hospital
- Rogue Valley Medical Center
- Tuality Healthcare

If a hospital is not listed in this section, the hospital did not provide comments on its HAI report for this period.

Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center

Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center is participating in several initiatives to reduce the incidence of hospital acquired infections. The hospital continues to monitor best practices and perform prospective review of standards in the prevention of surgical site infections.

- Member of the Oregon State Infection Prevention Collaborative 06/2010.
- Reporting of CABG SSI directly to surgeon for discussion.
- Introducing CHG showers for CABG and KPRO patients in 09/2010.
- Piloting Staph/MRSA screening for CABG and KPRO patients 09/2010.
- Sub committee reviewing practices and standards in the prevention of SSI 07/2010.

- Measurement of Environmental Cleaning 08/2010.
- Increased Infection Prevention staff from 1 FTE to 2 FTE 06/2010.

CABG SSI 01/2010 – 06/2010:

- All 7 SSI were superficial; 6 were superficial leg vein donor site infections and 1 was a superficial sternum infection.
- 4 of the 6 patients (one patient had both sternum and leg superficial surgical site infections) had reported co-morbid medical conditions, which included both diabetes and renal disease.

Mercy Medical Center

Comments regarding CLABSIs for 1/10-6/10:

After having had only one CLABSI for all of 2009, we unfortunately had 2 episodes during the first 6 months of 2010. One occurred in a catheter that had to be placed in a groin vein because of complete lack of more preferable sites and had to be done under emergent conditions because the patient was in shock. These features are known to increase infection risk but there was no other good choice. The other was due to Candida (yeast) and occurred in a patient who was colonized (yeast present on skin and other body surfaces) with Candida at multiple body sites, was receiving total intravenous nutrition, was on broad spectrum antibiotics, and was in acute kidney failure. All of these are well recognized risk factors for Candida blood stream infection. These are difficult cases where infection is very hard to prevent, but we have intensified our prevention efforts and have not seen any further CLABSIs in the past 7 months.

Oregon Health Science University

CLABSI in adult med/surg ICUs 1/2010-6/2010:

- There were six CLABSIs in the medical ICU and two CLABSIs in the surgical ICU during the first six months of 2010.
- The combined adult med/surg ICU rate has decreased from 3.14 per 1,000 central line days in 2009 to 2.33 in first 6 months of 2010.
- Preventing CLABSIs in the medical ICU is the current focus of OHSU's ongoing participation in the Oregon HAI Prevention Collaborative. As of October 1, this unit has gone two months without any CLABSIs.
- The OHSU surgical ICU has also made significant progress in preventing CLABSI, with no infections April through June.

CABG SSI 1/2010-6/2010:

- Of the 4 infections, all were superficial; 3 were superficial sternum infections and 1 was superficial saphenous vein donor site infection (leg).
- All of the patients who developed infections had significant co-morbid medical conditions, including poorly controlled diabetes (3), morbid obesity (2), hemorrhagic stroke (1), required aortic valve replacement (1), and failed renal transplant requiring hemodialysis (1).

All of the SCIP measures were followed for the patients who developed infections

Rogue Valley Medical Center

Rogue Valley Medical Center (RVMC) is dedicated to excellence by working to reduce our preventable HAIs. As a part of the hospital safety initiatives and movement toward a vision of excellent medical care, RVMC leadership has identified an opportunity to

decrease surgical site infections by joining the state-wide Oregon Patient Safety Commission HAI Prevention Collaborative. This provides an opportunity to reach beyond our geographical boundaries to discover and share best practices with others. During 2010, two additional infection prevention nurses have been added to our organization's Infection Prevention (IP) Program. This program is managed by a board certified Infection Control practitioner (CIC) and the program's medical director is board-certified in Infectious Diseases as well as having completed the SHEA/CDC Training Course in Healthcare Epidemiology.

Tuality Healthcare

Tuality Healthcare is committed to providing evidenced based care. We have implemented many nationally recognized infection prevention measures in our efforts to constantly improve patient care.

Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSIs):

In 2009 we identified an unusual occurrence of 3 CLABSIs in our ICU. After a thorough review of practices and implementing the use of a new Central Line Checklist, our rate has returned to zero and has remained zero.

CABG SSIs:

In 2009 we had 2 SSIs. After intensive review of both pre-op and post-op practices with surgeons and staff, we have returned to zero infections.

Knee Prosthesis SSIs:

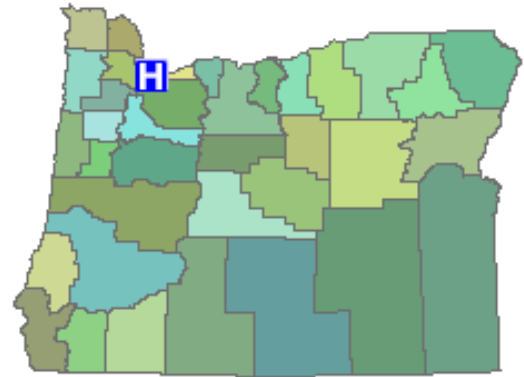
In 2009 we had zero infections. In June of 2010 we identified 1 SSI. We continue to aggressively track outcome data and validate compliance with evidenced base practice among surgeons and staff.

SCIP Measures:

We have implemented several measures to assure compliance with the SCIP core measures pertaining to the prophylactic administration of antibiotics. We demonstrate continuous improvements in our compliance with all three of these SCIP core measures by exceeding 97% so far in 2010.

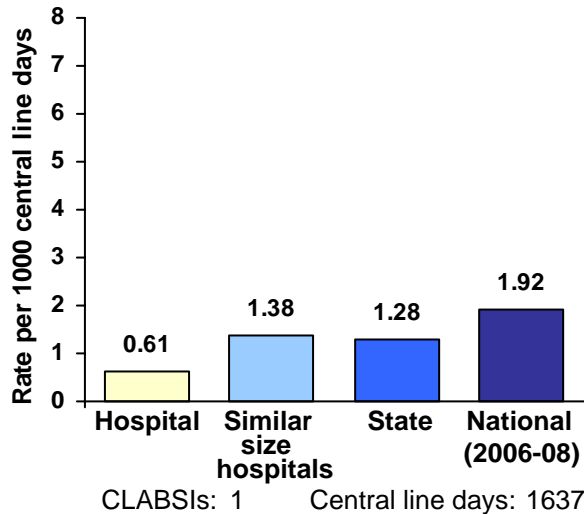

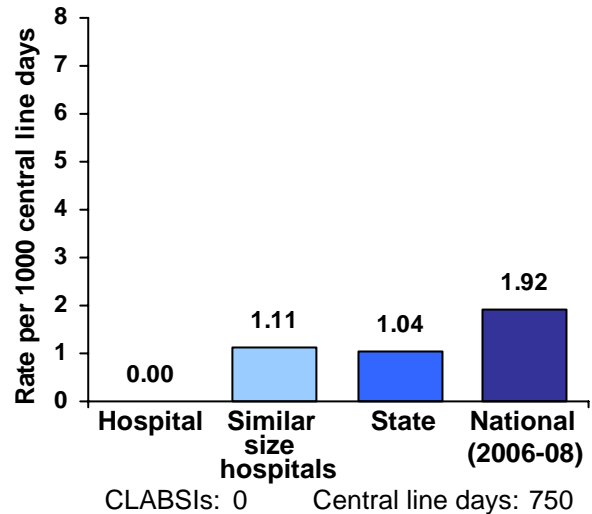


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Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSIs), 2009

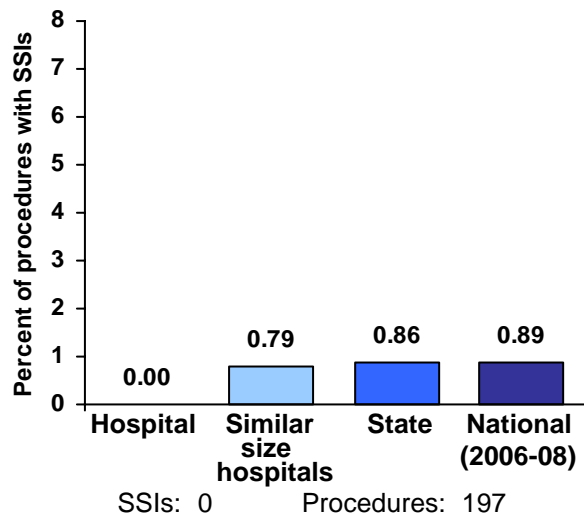


Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSIs), 1/2010-6/2010

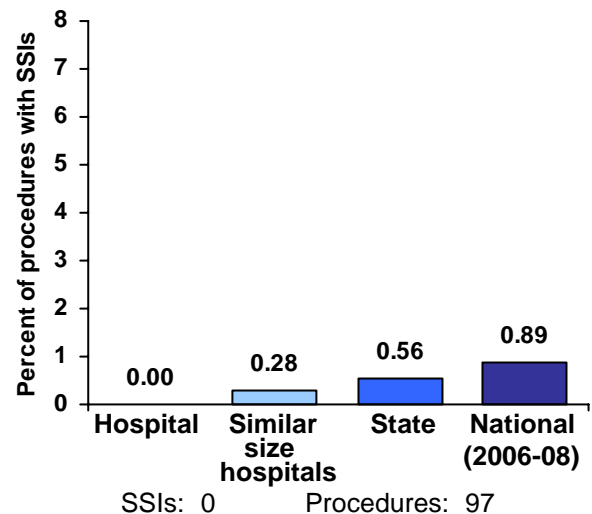


Surgical Site Infections (SSIs) by Procedure

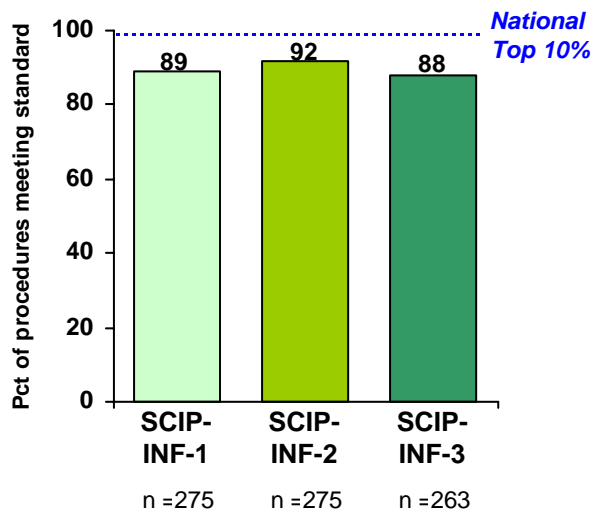

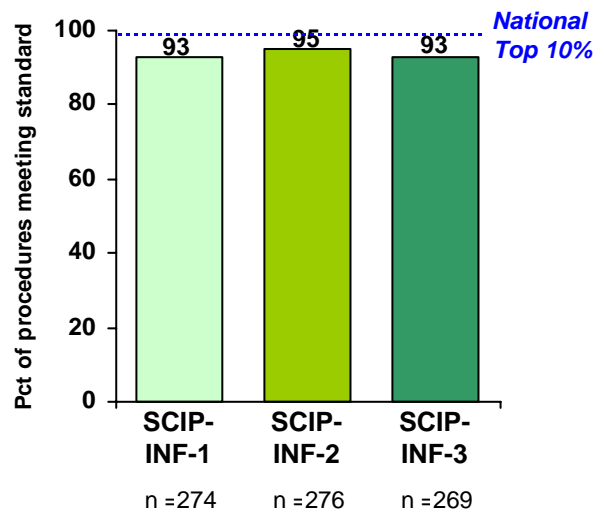

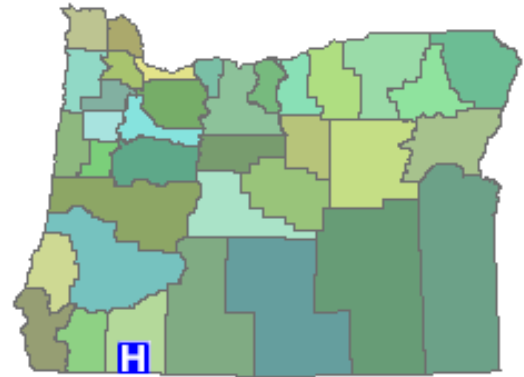

Process of Care Measures, 2009**



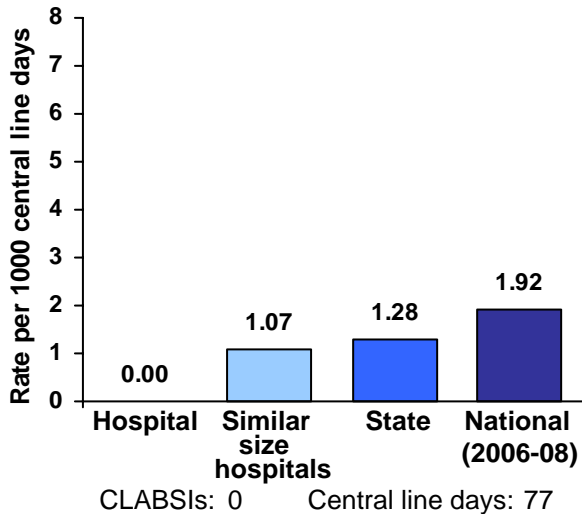

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Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSIs), 2009

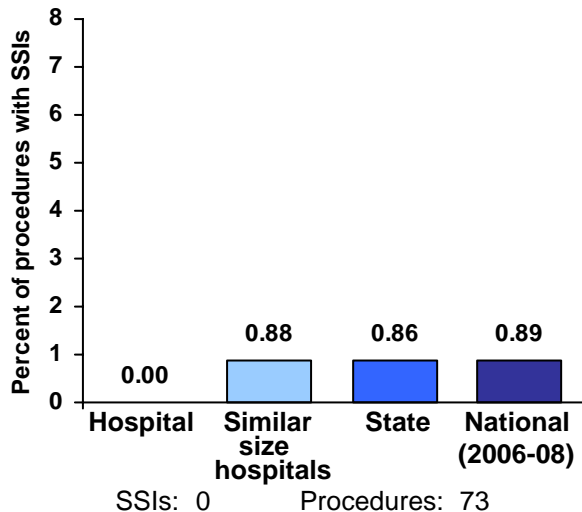

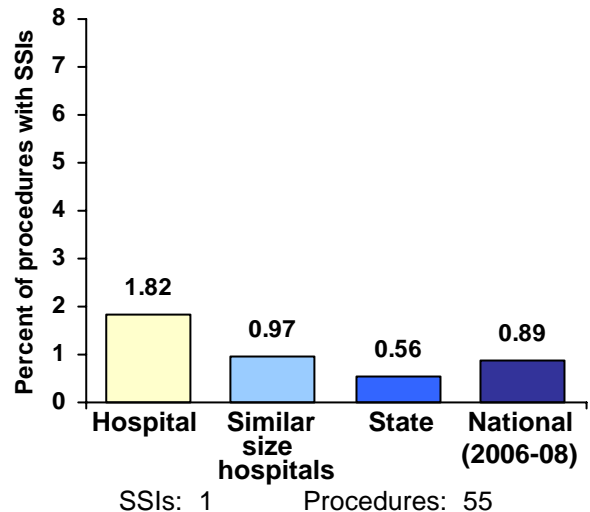

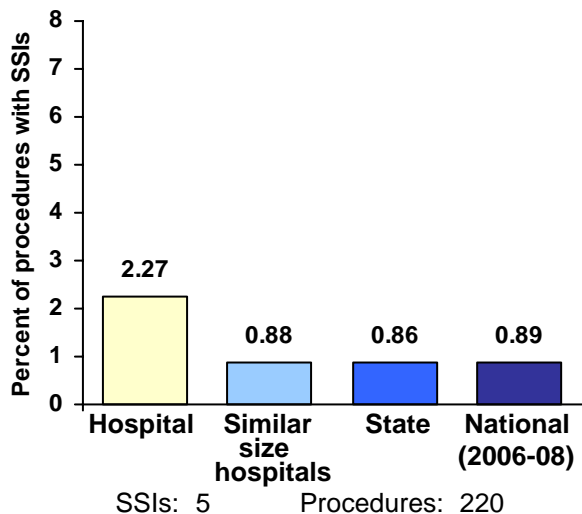


Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSIs), 1/2010-6/2010

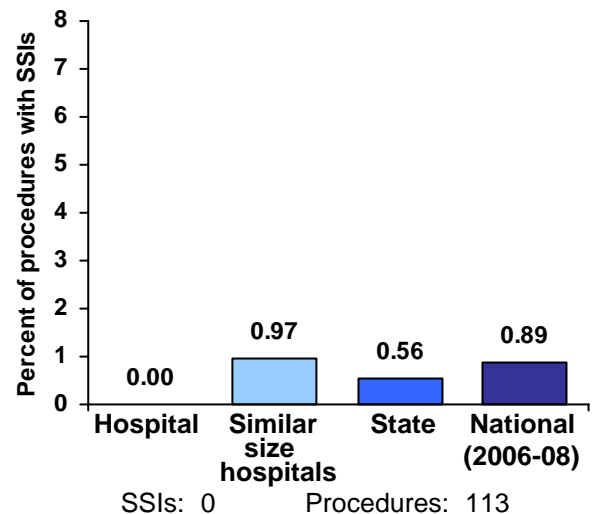

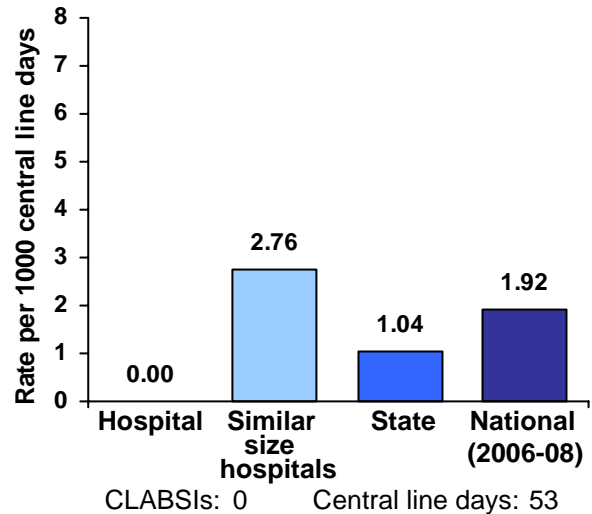

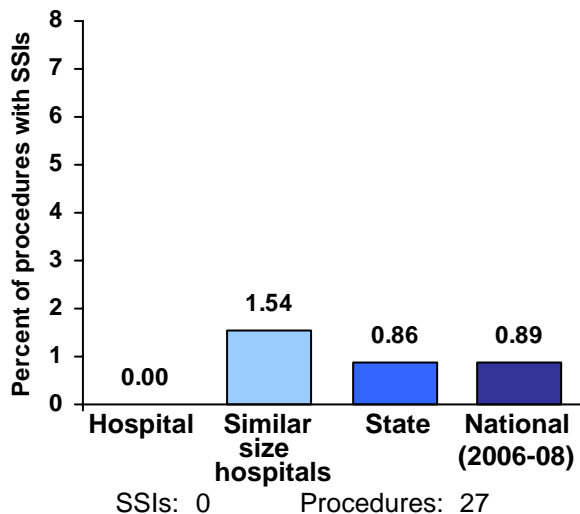


Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSIs), 1/2010-6/2010

Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSIs), 2009

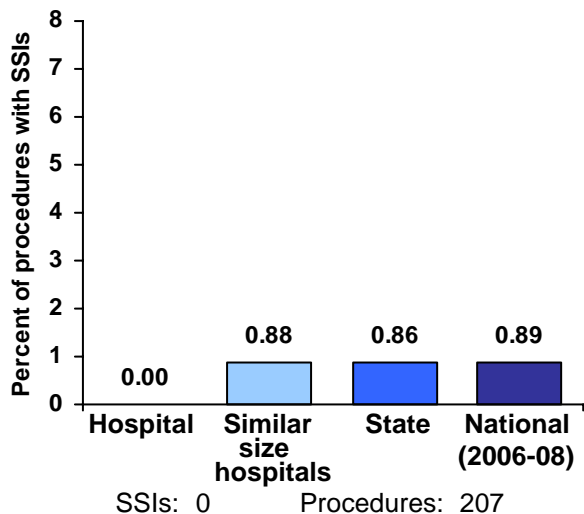


Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSIs), 1/2010-6/2010

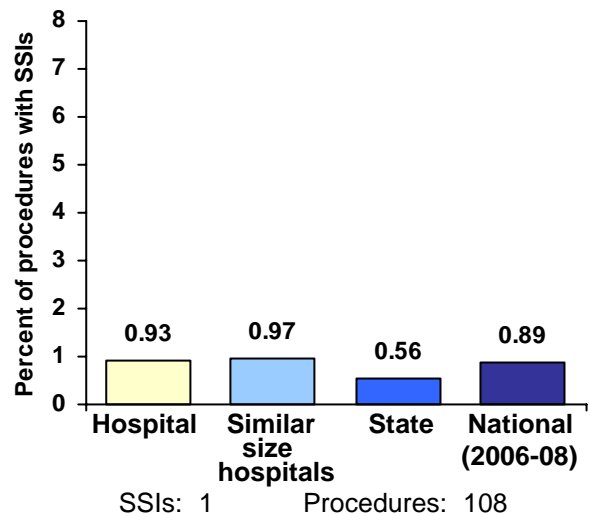


Surgical Site Infections (SSIs) by Procedure

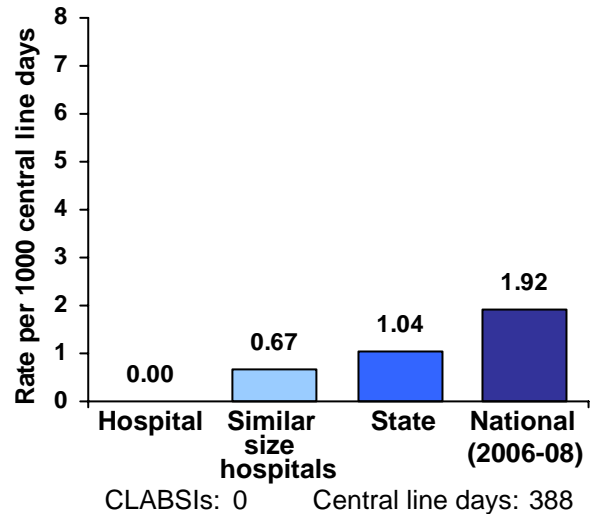


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Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSIs), 2009

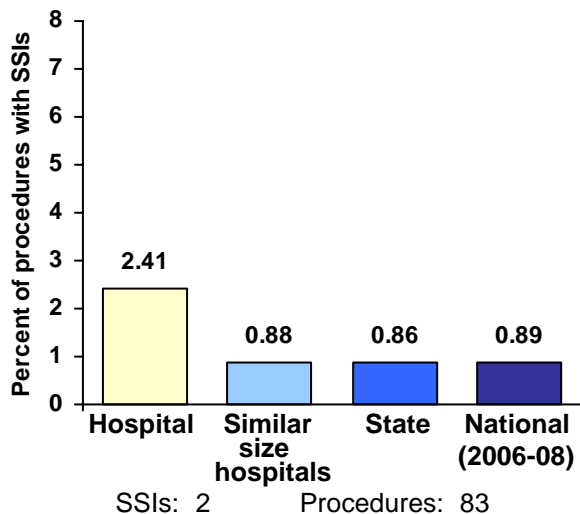


Central Line Associated Bloodstream Infections (CLABSIs), 1/2010-6/2010

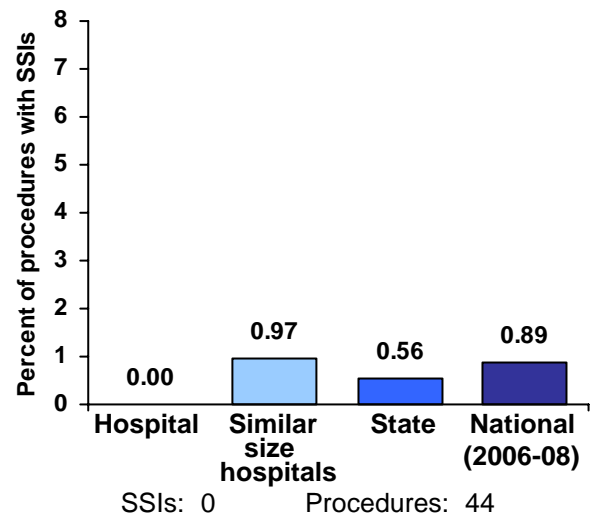

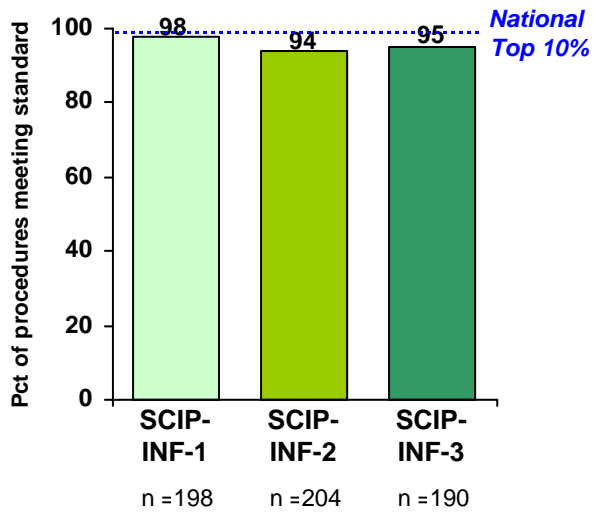
