**OPHP Active Enrollment**

<b>HKC</b>	5,419	<i>HKC = Healthy KidsConnect; Enrollment as of 7/29/2011</i> Healthy Kids (age 0-18) with Federal Poverty Levels over 200%; 201%-300% receive premium subsidies. HKC data is updated weekly with the next update on 7/25/2011.
<b>FHIAP</b>	7,726	<i>FHIAP = Family Health Insurance Assistance Program; Enrollment as of 8/1/2011 - includes 1,278 members also enrolled with OMIP and 312 enrolled with FMIP.</i> Provides premium subsidies for kids and adults up to 200% of FPL. FHIAP data is updated weekly with the next update on 8/8/2011.
<b>OMIP</b>	13,059	<i>OMIP = Oregon Medical Insurance Pool; enrollment of 13,059 is as of 5/5/2011</i> State High risk insurance pool that provides access to insurance for Oregonians with high risk or chronic conditions. OMIP data is updated monthly with the next update on 8/10/2011.
<b>FMIP</b>	822	<i>FMIP = Federal Medical Insurance Pool; enrollment as of 5/5/2011. FMIP data is updated monthly with the next update on 8/10/2011.</i>
<b>Total OPHP</b>	<b>25,436</b>	<i>Total OPHP enrollment is adjusted by the 1,278 FHIAP members that are also enrolled with OMIP and 312 enrolled with FMIP.</i>

<b>FMIP</b>	\$536	\$0	\$2,329	Amounts are based on processed claims for Calendar Year 2010 through November. The difference between the expenditures and revenues is covered by Federal funds.

For OMIP & FMIP, there is a lag of approximately 1 week to 1 month from when the claim is processed by the Third Party Administrator (TPA) to when the State wires funds to the TPA.
