**MHO Performance Targets and Readmissions
For September 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011**

Each MHO will have specific performance targets for assisting individuals in the process of recovery and facilitating appropriate transitions. Each MHO's performance targets will be based on the MHO's Region's historical utilization of state hospital and licensed 24/7 settings. Each movement from a higher level of service need to a lower level will count toward the performance target as defined below.

- Each individual that the MHO transitions out of the State hospital to a community based setting will count towards the target requirements.
- Each individual in acute care, approved for LTC by AMH, that are diverted to a licensed 24/7 community based setting or to community services and supports while on the waiting list will count towards the target requirements. This includes those individuals diverted to Post Acute Intermediate Treatment Services (PAITS).
- Each individual who transition from licensed 24/7 community based setting to a non-licensed 24/7 community based setting will count towards the target requirements.

Individuals who are approved for return to state hospital level of care:

- If an individual who has been discharged from the state hospital is approved for LTC within the following 12 months from discharge, the second discharge will not be considered toward an MHO's targeted discharge requirements.
