

Central Oregon Acute Care Council (CORACC)

The following are agreed-upon goals for the Central Oregon Adult Acute Care Region:

1. Development and management of an Acute Care Regional System for adult indigent and Oregon Health Plan individuals. CORACC will provide oversight of diversion services for clients in need of inpatient psychiatric hospitalization or incarceration.
2. Development of a continuum of supports and wrap around services which will effectively reduce the need for adults to access acute care services.
3. Creation of a system of care which allows adults in need of acute care to remain in Central Oregon for services.
4. Promotes linkage among regional mental health providers to promote effective treatment and Civil Commitment processes.
5. Ensure for ongoing linkage and partnering with local law enforcement to provide for appropriate use of services.
