

New Oregon Health Improvement Plan Committee – we invite you to join us!

In January, the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) will launch a strategic planning process to create a statewide Health Improvement Plan. The plan will focus on population health and strategies to improve the health of all Oregonians and reduce health care costs. These will include preventing and reducing tobacco use and obesity, early detection and management of chronic diseases and addressing other underlying conditions such as the social determinants of health.

The statewide Health Improvement Plan Committee will report to the Oregon Health Policy Board. This Committee will be guided by the OHA's Triple Aim of improving population health, improving the individual's experience of care and reducing per capita costs. The Committee will also be guided by the Oregon Health Fund Board's final report, "Aim High: Building a Healthy Oregon" (November 2008), particularly in reference to Building Block 4: Stimulate System Innovation and Improvement.
