☆ Capability to submit electronic syndromic surveillance data to public health agencies	Record advance directives for patients 65 years old or older
☆ Capability to submit electronic data to immunization registries	Provide a summary of care record for each transition of care or referral
☆ Capability to submit electronic data on reportable (as required by state or local law) lab results to public health agencies	Generate lists of patients by specific conditions to use for quality improvement, reduction of disparities, research or outreach
