**Subject:** Board of Licensed Dietitians Proposed Administrative Rules

Passage of Senate Bill 939 (Oregon Laws 2011, Chapter 630) by the 2011 Legislature brought the Board of Licensed Dietitians under the administration of the Oregon Health Licensing Agency (Agency). Section 12 of the enrolled version of Senate Bill 939 gave the Agency the authority to establish fees by rule. The statute states that the license is valid for one year. It was necessary to amend OAR 834-010-0050 to align with the statute. A temporary rule was put into place to address the issue. Temporary Rule 834-010-0050(T) will be made permanent with these administrative rules.

On September 22, 2011, the Board approved a 2011 - 2012 administrative rulemaking schedule. The Legislation and Rules Committee met on October 20, 2011, in order to review and recommend changes to the administrative rules. The administrative rule revisions were necessary for consistency, standardization and professional practice.

On November 10, 2011, the full board reviewed proposed administrative rule recommendations made by the Legislation and Rules Committee. The board approved the proposed administrative rules. Attached are:

- ◆ DRAFT copy of proposed rule language

The proposed administrative rules will be open for comment from December 1 through December 28, 2011. Proposed administrative rule text and updated information related to administrative rulemaking can be located on the board Web site at:
