4. Mail in notarized attested copy with completed renewal & application fee.

"Nice to know"

The above form and suggested directions are provided to help clarify and simplify the Board's request for a notarized copy of your CDR card. We hope it helps!

A "notarial act" or "notarization" is an act that a notary public of this state (Oregon) is authorized to perform, and includes certifying or attesting a copy. The "completed" short form ABOVE is sufficient for the licensing boards purposes of attestation of a copy of your signed CDR card.¹
