What is the purpose of the Meeting?

The purpose of the meeting is to review and sanction the permanent adoption of rules relating fee amendments, implementation of a uniform two-year licensing cycle and adjusted continuing education hours.

Is the public or licensees allowed to attend the Meeting?

Yes. Members of the public are invited and encouraged to be in attendance at all board/council meetings. Persons wishing to comment are asked to register on the sign-in roster prior to the meeting and indicate the agenda topic(s) they wish to discuss. Comments on topics not appearing on the agenda will be heard under public comment at the end of the meeting. Please wait for the chairperson to recognize the public prior to commenting on issues.

What if the board/council enters into Executive Session?

Prior to entering into executive session the board/council Chairperson will announce the nature of and the authority for holding executive session, at which time all audience members are asked to leave the room with the exception of news media and designated staff.

Executive session will be held according to one of the following authorities:

- ORS 192.660 (2)(f) to consider information or records exempt from public inspection for example examination questions;
- ORS 192.660 (2)(h) consultation with legal counsel concerning legal rights and duties regarding current litigation or litigation likely to be filed and

ORS 192.660 (2)(k) to consider information obtained as part of an investigation of a licensee or applicant by a health professional regulatory board.

- No final actions or final decisions will be made in executive session. The board/council will return to open session before taking any final action or making any final decisions.

Who do I contact if I have questions or need special accommodations?

The meeting location is accessible to persons with disabilities. A request for an interpreter for the hearing impaired or for other accommodations for persons with disabilities should be made at least 48 hours before the meeting.
