<a href="#">Brewery</a>	BRW & BRWNC	\$500 (annually)  And \$2.60 (annually) Alcohol Server Education fee if a BRW	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For the applicant who will make malt beverages and then primarily sell it at wholesale, but may also sell it at retail</li> <li>• Sell and distribute malt beverages containing not more than 6% alcohol by volume to wholesale and retail licensees of the OLCC</li> <li>• Import malt beverages into Oregon</li> <li>• Export malt beverages out of Oregon (Oregon has no requirements if you wish to ship or deliver malt beverages to a business or individual outside of Oregon; however, the state or country in which the business or individual is located may have requirements)</li> <li>• Sell malt beverages made on the premises and containing not more than 6% alcohol by volume to individuals (non-licensees of the OLCC) for consumption on the licensed premises and/or in quantities of not less than four gallons for consumption off the licensed premises</li> <li>• Not eligible to ship or deliver malt beverages directly to individuals (non-licensees of the OLCC) in Oregon (the individuals must take delivery of the malt beverage at the Brewery licensed premises)</li> <li>• May not sell wine or cider</li> <li>• Must obtain a privilege tax bond</li> <li>• Not eligible to obtain any special event license</li> <li>• BRW designates a license that allows tastings or other on-premises consumption of alcohol by patrons</li> <li>• BRWNC designates a licensee that does not allow tastings or other on-premises consumption of alcohol by patrons</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Brewery-Public House</a>	BP	\$250 (annually)  And \$2.60 (annually) Alcohol Server Education fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For the applicant who will make malt beverages and then primarily sell it at retail, but may also sell it at wholesale</li> <li>• Distribute malt beverages to wholesalers in Oregon</li> <li>• Can't import malt beverages into Oregon</li> <li>• Export malt beverages out of Oregon (Oregon has no requirements if you wish to ship or deliver malt beverages to a business or individual outside of Oregon; however, the state or country in which the business or individual is located may have requirements)</li> <li>• If make 5,000 barrels or less of malt beverages in a year can sell and distribute those malt beverages directly to retail licensees in Oregon</li> <li>• Sell malt beverages, wine, and cider to individuals in Oregon for consumption on or off the licensed business</li> <li>• Eligible to ship or deliver malt beverages directly to an Oregon resident</li> <li>• Eligible to apply for a "special event" license: SEBPH</li> <li>• Must obtain a privilege tax bond</li> </ul>

<a href="#">Certificate of Approval (for beer, wine, and cider)</a>	CERA	\$175 (for 5 years)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows a person in a US state other than Oregon to send malt beverages, wine, or cider to an Oregon wholesaler (the Oregon wholesaler can receive the alcohol only if the person sending the alcohol has a CERA)</li> <li>Allows a wholesaler in Oregon to receive malt beverages, wine, and cider directly from a person outside of the US (the Oregon wholesaler must get the CERA)</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Certificate of Approval (for distilled spirits)</a>	CER-D	No fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Required for manufacturers, importers, and others who import distilled spirits into Oregon for sale in the state. No need to apply for this certificate; it is automatically issued by the OLCC</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Direct Shipper Permit</a>	DS	\$50 (annually)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows certain businesses in a US state other than Oregon to send wine and cider directly from that state to a resident of Oregon</li> <li>Must obtain privilege tax bond</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Distillery</a>	DIST	\$100 (annually)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make and import distilled spirits into Oregon</li> <li>Export distilled spirits out of Oregon</li> <li>Sell distilled spirits to the OLCC (for sale in a liquor store)</li> <li>Provide tastings of distilled spirits on the premises</li> <li>Eligible to apply for a “special event” license: SED</li> <li>Does not obtain privilege tax bond</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Full On-Premises Sales, Commercial</a>	F-COM	\$400 (annually)  And \$2.60 (annually) Alcohol Server Education fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sell and serve distilled spirits, malt beverages, wine, and cider for consumption on the licensed premises (this is the license most “full-service” restaurant obtain)</li> <li>Eligible to apply to get pre-approved to cater some events off of the licensed premises (events that are small, usually closed to the general public, and where food service is the primary activity)</li> <li>Eligible to apply for a “special event” license: TUAL</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Full On-Premises Sales, Caterer</a>	F-CAT	\$400 (annually)  And \$2.60 (annually) Alcohol Server Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sell and serve distilled spirits, malt beverages, wine, and cider via pre-approved catering <u>for events off of the annually licensed premises</u> (these are events that are small, usually closed to the general public, and where food service is the primary activity)</li> <li>Eligible to apply for a “special event” license: TUAL</li> </ul>

<a href="#">Full On-Premises Sales, For-Profit Private Club</a>	F-CLU	\$400 (annually)  And \$2.60 (annually) Alcohol Server Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sell and serve distilled spirits, malt beverages, wine, and cider for consumption on the licensed premises, but only for members and guests</li> <li>• Must have a minimum of 100 members</li> <li>• Eligible to apply to get pre-approved to cater some events off of the licensed premises (events at which only members and guests may attend and where food service is the primary activity)</li> <li>• Eligible to apply for a “special event” license for a temporarily licensed event at which only members and guests may attend: TUAL</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Full On-Premises Sales, Nonprofit Private Club</a>	F-CLU	\$200 (annually)  And \$2.60 (annually) Alcohol Server Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sell and serve distilled spirits, malt beverages, wine, and cider for consumption on the licensed premises, but only for members and guests</li> <li>• Must have a minimum of 100 members</li> <li>• Must be a nonprofit corporation registered as such with Oregon’s Office of the Secretary of State for a minimum of one year immediately prior to the date of the application</li> <li>• Eligible to apply to get pre-approved to cater some events off of the licensed premises (events at which only members and guests may attend and where food service is the primary activity)</li> <li>• Eligible to apply for a “special event” license for a temporarily licensed event at which only members and guests may attend: TUAL</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Full On-Premises Sales, Other Public Location</a>	F-PL	\$400 (annually)  And \$2.60 (annually) Alcohol Server Education fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sell and serve distilled spirits, malt beverages, wine, and cider for consumption on the licensed premises</li> <li>• Eligible to apply to get pre-approved to cater some events off of the licensed premises (events that are small, usually closed to the general public, and where food service is the primary activity)</li> <li>• Eligible to apply for a “special event” license: TUAL</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Full On-Premises Sales, Public Passenger Carrier</a>	F-PC	\$400 (annually)  And \$2.60 (annually) Alcohol Server Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Allows an airline, railroad, or tour boat to sell and serve distilled spirits, malt beverages, wine, and cider for consumption on the licensed premises</li> <li>• Eligible to apply for a “special event” license: TUAL</li> </ul>

<a href="#">Grower Sales Privilege</a>	GSP & GSPNC	\$250 (annually)  And \$2.60 (annually) Alcohol Server Education fee if a GSP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Import, store, and export wine and cider made from fruit or grapes grown in Oregon under the control of the licensee (note this license doesn't allow the manufacture of wine or cider)</li> <li>• Sell such wine or cider to wholesalers in Oregon</li> <li>• Export such wine or cider out of Oregon</li> <li>• Sell and distribute such wine or cider directly to retail licensees in Oregon</li> <li>• Sell such wine or cider to individuals in Oregon for consumption on or off the licensed business</li> <li>• Eligible to ship such wine and cider directly to an Oregon resident</li> <li>• Eligible to apply for a "special event" license: SEG</li> <li>• Must obtain privilege tax bond</li> <li>• GSP designates a license that allows tastings or other on-premises consumption of alcohol by patrons</li> <li>• GSPNC designates a licensee that does not allow tastings or other on-premises consumption of alcohol by patrons</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Limited On-Premises Sales</a>	L	\$200 (annually)  And \$2.60 (annually) Alcohol Server Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sell and serve malt beverages, wine, and cider for consumption on the licensed premises</li> <li>• Sell malt beverages in a container holding seven or more gallons for consumption off the licensed premises</li> <li>• Eligible to apply to get pre-approved to cater some events off of the licensed premises (events that are small, usually closed to the general public, and where food service is the primary activity)</li> <li>• Eligible to apply for a "special event" license: TUAL</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Off-Premises Sales</a>	O	\$100 (annually)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sell factory-sealed containers of malt beverages, wine, and cider at retail to individuals in Oregon for consumption off the licensed premises</li> <li>• Eligible to apply to get pre-approval to provide sample tastings of malt beverages, wine, and cider for consumption on the premises</li> <li>• Eligible to ship manufacturer-sealed containers of malt beverages, wine, or cider directly to an Oregon resident</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Warehouse</a>	WH	\$100 (annually)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Store, import, export, and produce malt beverages, wine, and cider</li> <li>• In Oregon, primarily sell or ship to other Oregon wholesalers; however, some exceptions may apply</li> </ul> <p>Must obtain privilege tax bond</p>
<a href="#">Wholesale Malt Beverage and Wine</a>	WMBW	\$275 (annually)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Store, import, export, and sell malt beverages, wine, and cider at wholesale to Oregon retail licensees</li> <li>• Make limited retail sales of malt beverages, wine, and cider to the public</li> <li>• Not eligible to ship or deliver malt beverages, wine, or cider directly to individuals (non-licensees of the OLCC) in Oregon (the individuals must take delivery of the malt beverage, wine, or cider at the WMBW licensed premises)</li> <li>• Must obtain privilege tax bond</li> </ul>

<a href="#">Wine Self-Distribution Permit</a>	WSD	\$100 (annually)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows a manufacturer of wine and cider in a US state other than Oregon to sell and ship such wine and cider directly to an Oregon retail licensee <u>but only if the Oregon retailer holds a valid endorsement issued by the OLCC authorizing the receipt of wine or cider from the holder of a Wine Self-Distribution Permit</u></li> <li>Must obtain privilege tax bond</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Winery</a>	WY and WYNC	\$250 (annually)  And \$2.60 (annually) Alcohol Server Education fee if a WY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Manufacture, store, and export wine and cider</li> <li>Sell wine and cider to wholesale and retail licensees in Oregon</li> <li>Sell malt beverages, wine, and cider to individuals in Oregon for consumption on or off the licensed business</li> <li>Eligible to ship wine and cider directly to an Oregon resident</li> <li>Eligible to apply for a "special event" license: SEW</li> <li>Must obtain privilege tax bond</li> <li>WY designates a license that allows tastings or other on-premises consumption of alcohol by patrons</li> <li>WYNC designates a licensee that does not allow tastings or other on-premises consumption of alcohol by patrons</li> </ul>

License Type	License Code	License Fee	A Summary of <b>Primary</b> License Privileges and Requirements
<a href="#">Temporary Sales License</a>	TSL	\$50 (per license day)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sell and serve distilled spirits, malt beverages, wine, and cider for consumption on the special event licensed premises</li> <li>Sell factory-sealed containers of beer, wine, or cider at retail to individuals in Oregon for consumption off of the special event licensed premises</li> <li>Can't allow patrons to take <u>any</u> distilled spirits off of the special event licensed premises (whether in an open or sealed container)</li> <li>A person or organization making alcoholic beverages within Oregon or importing or causing to be imported into Oregon an alcoholic beverage for sale or distribution in Oregon is <b>NOT</b> eligible for this license. This includes the following OLCC licensees: Brewery; CERA; CERD; Distillery; Grower Sales Privilege; Warehouse; Wholesale Malt Beverage and Wine; and Winery. This also includes wineries, breweries, distilleries, and wholesalers in other states.</li> </ul>

<a href="#">Temporary Use of an Annual License</a>	TUAL	No license fee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any type of Full-On Premises Sales licensee and any Limited On-Premises Sales licensee may apply for this license</li> <li>Allows a Full On-Premises Sales licensee to sell and serve distilled spirits, malt beverages, wine, and cider for consumption on the special event licensed premises</li> <li>Allows a Limited On-Premises Sales licensee to sell and serve malt beverages, wine, and cider for consumption on the special event licensed premises</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Special Event Winery</a>	SEW	\$10 (per license day)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows an Oregon Winery licensee to sell malt beverages, wine, and cider for consumption on the special event licensed premises or in manufacturer-sealed containers for consumption off of the special event licensed premises</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Special Event Grower</a>	SEG	\$10 (per license day)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows an Oregon Grower Sales Privilege licensee to sell wine and cider allowed to be sold under the annual Grower Sales Privilege license for consumption on the special event licensed premises or in manufacturer-sealed containers for consumption off of the special event licensed premise</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Special Event Brewery Public House</a>	SEBPH	\$10 (per license day)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows an Oregon Brewery-Public House licensee to sell malt beverages, wine, and cider for consumption on the special event licensed premises or in manufacturer-sealed containers for consumption off of the special event licensed premises</li> </ul>
<a href="#">Special Event Distillery</a>	SED	\$10 (per license day)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows an Oregon Distillery licensee to provide tastings and sell drinks of distilled liquor manufactured by the Oregon Distillery licensee on the special event licensed premises when the distilled liquor is approved for sale in Oregon</li> <li>If the licensee is a distillery retail outlet agent, may sell factory-sealed containers of distilled liquor manufactured by the licensee for consumption off the licensed premises of the event</li> </ul>
