

## AT-A-GLANCE

### OAR 845-006-0425 Hours of Sale

#### Final Action

(To amend one existing rule)

June 2009

This rule sets the hours during which licensees of the Commission may sell, dispense, serve, allow consumption of, or allow removal of alcohol.

The petitioners, the Food & Beverage Concessionaires at the Portland International Airport (PDX), are requesting to amend this rule by adding language which would allow both On-Premises and Off-Premises sales licensees located at PDX to sell and serve alcohol between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 2:30 a.m. This would be an additional two hours in the morning outside of the currently allowed hours of 7:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m.

In order to keep the exception as narrow as possible, the rule amendments recommended by staff differ from the petitioner's original request in that they would only allow Off-Premises sales at PDX between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m., and only to a ticketed airline passenger with a valid same-day boarding pass.

Because the petitioners also requested On-Premises sales, an alternate option, which would not be quite as narrow, would be to allow both On-Premises and Off-Premises sales at PDX between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m., and again, only to a ticketed airline passenger with a valid same-day boarding pass.
