There were 12 stipulated settlement agreements for consideration; Portsmouth Pizza & Pub, The Cooney Island Tavern, Rivershore Bar & Grill, Flatbread Community Oven, Ray's Food Place #1, Mixers Bar & Grill, Mt Park Grocery & Deli, Frank N Steins Pub, The Vinyl Club, Margaritas, Red Line Sports Bar & Grill, and Astro Lounge. Commissioner Rice asked about the DPSST requirements for security and providing private security. Ms. Routt said that the language is what is in statute and include employees who have gone through the training or people hired by the licensee to provide security.
