**INTRODUCTIONS AND OVERVIEW OF AGENDA:** Introductions made by each committee member. No additions to the agenda.

**APPROVAL OF LAST MEETING MINUTES:**

Motion made and seconded to accept the October 2010 minutes.

**MASTERLIST UPDATE:**

All items currently tabled.

**LEGISLATIVE CONCEPTS:**

**LC 537-** Allows OLCC to impose application fee for initial license application. Farshad Allahdadi shared the idea behind LC 537 and the policy option package for using the fee to fund a license investigator and IT work on the new license project. Discussed other possible fund distributions, i.e. have part of the fee apply to application cost if license is granted, especially if the fee is \$750.00.

**LC 539-** Farshad gave a brief review of winery licenses. Concerns modeling federal permits. Discussed opposition with this method and reasons that some licenses may object. Currently some retailers may be enjoying benefits which were meant for wineries, but the retailer does not produce wine. Concept attempts to clarify small winery credit issue.

**LC 540-** Amendment made to include the ability for local governments to establish geographic area within a community. Discussed alcohol impact area as defined. Scott Winkels expressed appreciation for this concept being crafted. Linda pointed out if zoning requirements are not met then it will be a denial criteria and would probably need a statute change. Unlawful activity is limited in the rule which Linda will have Judith look at the rule. Zoning part of licensing criteria would need a legislative change. Suggestion to move item into Legislative Solutions workgroup and Linda will keep the enforcement issue, but the legislative change will transfer to this group.
