## **Jantzen Beach liquor store moving across I-5 to larger site, says OLCC**

In January, the Stateline liquor store in Portland's Jantzen Beach will move a few hundred yards northeast to the other side of I-5 -- to a larger, more modern facility with six times the parking.

The Oregon Liquor Control Commission approved Agent Paul Babin's request to relocate from 11915 N. Center Ave. to 1190 N. Jantzen Ave.

Jim MacAlistaire, OLCC's director of Retail Services, termed the move as "customer friendly." The new store will be easy to find, have a larger sales floor for better product display, meet modern appearance standards and offer more parking slots for customers, he explained.

Annual sales would be expected to increase at least 10 percent from the present \$4 million level. A grand opening at the new location is planned for Jan. 31, 2008.
