OLCC sanctions Metro, Coast licensees for liquor law violations

The licensee of **Tiga**, 1465 NE Prescott., Portland, will pay a \$2,640 civil penalty (by Oct. 29) or serve a 16-day license suspension for two liquor law violations, under a stipulated settlement agreement with the Oregon Liquor Control Commission.

The first violation (OAR 845-006-0335(1)(a)(b)(c)) occurred March 28 during an OLCC compliance check when an employee failed to verify the age of a minor before selling him alcohol. A second violation (ORS 471.360(1)(b)) was charged when an employee was permitted to sell, mix, or serve alcoholic beverages – or supervise those who do – without a valid service permit.

The business has an on-premises beer-wine-distilled spirits sales license (FCOM). The licensee is Paper Hat, Inc.; Zach Sargent, president; Djamilah Troncelliti, treasurer; Maryam Troncelliti, secretary.

In a settlement, the licensee of **Labor Temple Diner & Bar** (FCOM), 934 Duane St., Astoria, agreed to pay a \$2,475 civil penalty by Oct. 29 or serve a 15-day suspension starting Nov. 3. In violation of ORS 471.410(1), two employees knowingly sold or served alcohol to three visibly intoxicated persons. One employee also made alcohol available to another visibly intoxicated person. The licensee is LT Diner, LLC; David Warner, managing member; Christina Warner, member.

The two Labor Temple employees also entered settlement agreements with the OLCC. The service permittee who made alcohol available to four visibly intoxicated persons will pay a \$325 fine by Oct. 29 or serve a 13-day permit suspension. The other permittee agreed to pay a \$275 civil penalty by Oct. 29 or serve an 11-day suspension.

In a settlement, licensee Marat E. Astvatsatryan of **Kievan Market** (off-premises beer-wine sales license – O), 21687 Hwy. 99 E., Aurora, agreed to pay a \$1,485 civil penalty by Oct. 29 or serve a nine-day license suspension (starting Nov. 3). During a March 30 Marion County Sheriff's Office compliance check, the licensee failed to verify the age of a minor before selling him alcohol.

The licensee of **The Troller Restaurant & Lounge** (FCOM), 307 Mooring Basin Rd., Garibaldi, agreed to pay a \$1,155 civil penalty by Oct. 29 or serve a seven-day suspension starting Nov. 3. The violation occurred when the licensee permitted an employee to sell, mix, or serve alcoholic beverages – or supervise those who do – without a valid service permit. The licensee is Bayview Brewing LLC; Sophia Skeens, member.

In a settlement, the licensee of **Circle K/76** (O), 2281 NE 181st, Portland, agreed to pay a \$1,155 civil penalty by Oct. 29 or serve a seven-day suspension (starting Nov. 3) because an employee failed to verify the age of a minor before selling him alcohol during a March 28 Portland police compliance check. The licensee is

Kayo Oil Co.; Rodd Percy, president; Ronald Sumner, W. Thomas Skok, Michael Krampf, vice presidents; ConocoPhillips Co., stockholder.

The licensee of **Ming Yang Restaurant** (on-premises beer-wine sales license - L), *5069 River Rd. N., Keizer*, agreed to pay an \$825 civil penalty by Oct. 29 or serve a five-day suspension because a corporate principal failed to verify the age of a minor before selling him alcohol during a March 30 Marion County Sheriff's Office compliance check. The licensee is Ming Yang Restaurant, Inc.; David Ming-Yang Zhen, president; Cindy Hong-Mei Zhen, vice president.

Cases ratified

The former licensee of **Civic Food Mart**, *729 N. Portland Blvd., Portland*, will receive a letter of reprimand in OLCC files because a corporate principal sold glass containers of malt beverages to OLCC inspectors in July in violation of OAR 845-005-0355. The licensee's temporary letter of authority to operate, which has since been revoked, contained a restriction that stated "no sale of any glass containers of malt beverages." The licensee was Cho Enterprises, Inc.; Kwang Rae Cho, president; Mi Soon Jung, vice president; Cho Kim Lee, secretary.
