OLCC Commissioners issue 17 sanctions, grant 4 liquor licenses and appoint 3 liquor store agents

PORTLAND, Ore. - At their monthly meeting Dec. 17 and 18, the Commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission ratified the following sanctions based on stipulated settlements:

Stillwater, 1951 Ashland Street, Ashland; will pay a \$4,950 civil penalty or serve a 30-day suspension for failure to maintain liquor liability insurance or a bond with a corporate surety in the amount of not less than \$300,000. Licensee is Stillwater Brew Pub, LLC, Christopher Moeschl, Managing Member.

Boulevard Café/Jesse James Club, 7958 SW Barbur Boulevard, Portland; will pay a \$3,300 civil penalty or serve a 20-day suspension for two violations. The licensee permitted an employee to mix, sell, or serve alcoholic beverages or supervise those who do without a service permit as well as failed to evict a patron when licensee's employees knew he engaged in noisy, disorderly or unlawful activities. Licensee is Boulevard Café, Inc., Victor Mosso, Debra Mosso and Juanita Mosso, Corporate Principals.

Center Market #12, 604 Main Street, Tillamook; will pay a civil penalty of \$1,485 and serve a 30-day suspension or serve a 39-day suspension for failure to comply with a restriction on the license as well as failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him to buy an alcoholic beverage when he reasonably appeared under 26. Center Market #12 was granted with a restriction that requires the licensee to have age verification equipment and to utilize the equipment to verify the age of any person who reasonably appears under age 26 who attempts to purchase alcohol. Licensee is Amrit, Inc., Bahadur Singh, Corporate Principal.

B Mers Can Can Room, 3212 Triangle Drive, Salem; will pay a \$5,280 civil penalty or serve a 32-day suspension for two violations. Licensee's employees permitted two minors to buy, be served or drink alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises as well as permitted two minors to be on the licensed premises or an area of the licensed premises that is prohibited to minors. Licensee is B-Mers Can Can room, LLC, Kerrie Rodriguez, Randy Jacobsen, Judy Jacobsen and Lorenzo Rodriguez, Members.

Iggy's Bar & Grill, 9015 Portland Road NE, Brooks; will pay a \$2,970 civil penalty or serve an 18-day suspension for licensee's employee knowingly selling, giving or making alcoholic liquor available to a visibly intoxicated person as well as licensee permitting an employee to mix, sell, or serve alcoholic beverages or supervise those who do without a service permit. Licensee is Orfal's, Inc., Gilbert Ray, Corporate Principal.

Boom's Restaurant, 3960 Center Street NE, Salem; will pay a \$1,155 civil penalty and serve a 23-day suspension or serve a 30-day suspension for making a false representation or statement to the Commission in order to induce or prevent action by the Commission as well as permitting a service permittee who was a minor into an area prohibited to minors. Licensee is Boom's Restaurant Corp., Jose Duarte, Corporate Principal.

For an employee(s) failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him/her to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he/she reasonably appeared to be under 26:

Bill's Market, 293 Bridge Street, Lafayette; will pay a \$4,125 civil penalty or serve a 25-day suspension. Licensees are Hee Sung Oh and Byung Kim.

Hiroshi's Anzen, 736 NE MLK Boulevard, Portland; will pay a \$1,485 civil penalty or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Hiroshi Enterprises, Inc., Charles Matsushima and Janie Matsushima, Corporate Principals.

Woody's Pub & Grille, 42 North Front Street, Medford; will pay a \$1,485 civil penalty or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Molon Labe, LLC, Steven Brown and Trevor Southworth, Members.

Scotts Mills Market, 340 Grandview Avenue, Scotts Mills; will pay a civil penalty of \$330 or serve a two-day suspension. Licensee is MCM Corporation, Wan Park and Tae Yoon, Corporate Principals.

Wine Depot & Deli, 300 SW 2nd, Albany; will pay a \$1,485 civil penalty or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Morse 2 Ltd., Matthew S. Morse and Marcia J. Morse, Corporate Principals.

La Azteca, 153 Grant Street, Woodburn; will install and use age verification equipment and will pay a civil penalty of \$330 or serve a two-day suspension. Licensee is Tienda Mexicana La Azteca, Inc., Mario O. Paniagua, Corporate Principal.

For permitting an employee(s) to sell, mix, or serve alcohol or supervise those who do without a service permit:

Pizza Factory, 1188 Main St., Lebanon; will pay a \$1,485 civil penalty or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Sege, LLC, Jimi Kim and Yoonho Suh, Members.

Corner Saloon, 2509 S. Borland Road, Tualatin; will pay a \$1,485 civil penalty or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is The Corner, Inc., Simon Ostler, Corporate Principal.

Bottoms Up, 16900 NW St. Helens Rd., Portland; will pay a \$1,485 civil penalty or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Oregon River Tavern, Inc., Bassam Moussa, Corporate Principal.

Margaritas, 1593 Mt. Hood Ave., Woodburn; will pay a \$3,795 civil penalty or serve a 23-day suspension. Licensee is Dancin Bear Properties, LLC, Jackie Mackey, Managing Member.

Pizza Hut, 2215 14th Ave. SE, Albany; will pay a \$1,485 civil penalty or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Pizza Hut of Southeast Kansas, Inc., J. Larry Fugate, Corporate Principal.

The commissioners approved the following liquor licenses:

Covered Bridge Coffee House, 38765 N. Main St. Scio (Limited On and Off-Premises). Licensee is Covered Bridge Coffee House, LLC.

Gresham Texaco, 1545 NE 181st Ave., Gresham (Off-Premises). Licensee is Golden Gate Enterprises, LLC

In & Out Food Market, 800 N. Killingsworth, Portland (Off-Premises). License was granted with a restriction. Licensee is Jamal, Inc.

International Wine Discoveries, 840 SE Alder St., Portland (Off-Premises). Licensee is Wino Industries, LLC.

The commissioners appointed three liquor agents to stores in Amity, Grants Pass and Bend.

Kyung (Steve) Kim was appointed as the liquor agent for store #1039 in Amity.

Herb Heier was appointed liquor agent for store #1214 in Grants Pass.

John Biber was appointed liquor agent for the Bend – North #1163 store.

Retail liquor agents are independent contractors; they are not state employees. The Retail Services Division of the OLCC works closely with liquor agents to help them understand and follow liquor regulations and store operating procedures.

The five citizen commissioners are the policy-making body of the OLCC. They meet monthly for one or two days to make decisions on liquor licenses, rules, contested case hearings and appointments of liquor store agents. Commission meetings are held every other month at OLCC's main office, 9079 SE McLoughlin
