OLCC Commissioners issue seven sanctions to businesses

PORTLAND, Ore. – At their monthly meeting Jan. 14, the commissioners of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission ratified the following sanctions based on stipulated settlements:

Bradley's Bar & Grill, 11995 N. Center, Portland; has paid a fine of \$2,970 for two violations. The first violation was for an employee permitting two minors to buy, be served or drink alcoholic beverages at the licensed business. The second violation was for an employee permitting two minors to be on the licensed business that is prohibited to minors. Licensee is Oregon Restaurant Services, Inc.; Dan Fisher, Marwin Hofer, Michael Evans, Jim Thares and (605) Holdings, Inc., corporate principals.

For an employee(s) failing to verify the age of a minor before allowing him/her to buy or be served an alcoholic beverage when he/she reasonably appeared to be under 26:

Wasson Brothers Winery, 17020 Ruben Lane, Sandy; has paid a \$330 fine and will install age verification equipment. The licensee will use the equipment to verify the age of every patron who reasonably appears to be under 26 years of age. The licensee is Wasson Brothers Winery, LLC; James Wasson, John Wasson, Loan Wasson, and Mildred Wasson, members.

Shari's of Garden Home, 7451 SW Garden Home Rd., Portland; will pay a \$330 fine or serve a two-day suspension in addition to installing age verification equipment. The licensee will use the equipment to verify the age of every patron who reasonably appears to be under 26 years of age. The licensee will be removed from the Responsible Vendor Program. Licensee is Shari's Management Corporation; Bruce MacDiarmid, Bobby Ray Damron, Richard Olsen, Alan Hartley, R. Adam Smith, Kerry Kramp, and Shari's Holding Company, LLC, corporate principals.

Onion Grill Restaurant, 835 Chetco Ave., Brookings; will pay a fine of \$330 or serve a two-day license suspension in addition to installing age verification equipment. The licensee will use the equipment to verify the age of every patron who reasonably appears to be under 26 years of age. Licensee is Lee's Dragon Gate Restaurant, Inc., George Lee and Letty Lee, corporate principals.

River Lodge & Grill, #6 Marine Drive NE, Boardman; will pay a fine of \$330 or serve a two-day license suspension in addition to installing age verification equipment. The licensee will use the equipment to verify the age of every patron who reasonably appears to be under 26 years of age. Licensees are Norpac Management, LLC; North Pacific Management, Inc., member and TG Hotel, LLC; Anthony Glavin and Howard Talbitzer, members.

For permitting an employee(s) to mix, sell, or serve alcohol or supervise those who do without a service permit:

BK Mulligan's, 266 SE Highway 101, Lincoln City; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day suspension. Licensee is Coastal Associates, Inc., Gary Shevik and Rebecca Hall, corporate principals.

The Colony Pub, 21568 Hwy 99E, Aurora; will pay a fine of \$1,485 or serve a nine-day license suspension. Licensee is RLN Corporation, Russell Newcomer and Lauren Newcomer, corporate principals.

The five citizen commissioners are the policy-making body of the OLCC. They meet monthly for one or two days to make decisions on liquor licenses, rules, contested case hearings and appointments of liquor store agents. Commission meetings are held every other month at OLCC's main office, 9079 SE McLoughlin Blvd., Room 103A in Portland. Subsequent months, the meetings are held via phone.
