BOARD ACTION REPORT
May 15, 2010

Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order with the Board on May 5, 2010. In this Order Licensee agreed to withdraw from practice pending the conclusion of the Board's investigation.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain healthcare providers, including physicians, in the state of Oregon. Robert John Grimm, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state of Oregon.

2.

The Board received credible information regarding Licensee that resulted in the Board initiating an investigation. The results of the Board's investigation to date have raised concerns to the extent that the Board believes it necessary that Licensee agree to cease the practice of medicine until the investigation is completed.

3.

In order to address the concerns of the Board, Licensee and the Board agree to enter into this Interim Stipulated Order, which provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions, effective at 5:00 PM on May 7, 2010.

3.1 Licensee voluntarily withdraws from the practice of medicine and his license is placed in inactive status pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

3.2 Licensee acknowledges that, under the terms of this order, he is prohibited from engaging in the practice of medicine, as defined in ORS 677.085, to include being prohibited from prescribing any drug or medicine.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain healthcare providers, including physician assistants, in the state of Oregon. Eduardo Rodolfo Valenzuela, PA (Licensee) is a licensed physician assistant in the state of Oregon. Licensee's Oregon physician assistant license is currently in an inactive status.

2.

On May 4, 2010, the Board received credible information regarding Licensee that resulted in the Board initiating an investigation. The information was developed during a current investigation by the Florence Police Department regarding the Licensee's prescribing practice and the care and treatment the Licensee provided to several patients outside the traditional clinical setting. The results of the Board's investigation to date have raised concerns to the extent that the Board believes it necessary that Licensee agree to cease the practice of medicine until the investigation is completed.

3.

In order to address the concerns of the Board, Licensee and the Board agree to enter into this Interim Stipulated Order, which provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions effective the date this Order is signed by Licensee:

1 Pursuant to ORS 676.175, Board investigative materials are confidential and shall not be
2 subject to public disclosure, nor shall they be admissible as evidence in any judicial proceeding.
3 However, as a stipulation this Order is a public document.
