The Board of Medical Examiners (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the state of Oregon. Neal Eugene Berner, MD (Applicant) is applying for a medical license in the state of Oregon.

2.

On September 19, 2005, Applicant submitted an application for medical licensure in the state of Oregon. Applicant reported that he had ceased clinical practice in May of 1990 and that his Kansas medical license had been limited to "exempt" status in May of 1990 and later suspended for a minimum period of 24 months beginning October 31, 1990. This order was terminated by Kansas on June 12, 1993. Applicant states that he worked as a consultant for the Kansas Disability Determination Service (KDDS) from May of 1990 until February of 2005. He is requesting a license limited to administrative medicine.

Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (chapter 183), Oregon Revised Statutes, and fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing and any appeal there from by the signing of and entry of this Order in the Board's records.

The Board of Medical Examiners (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the state of Oregon. William Mark Dean, MD (Applicant) is applying for a medical license in the state of Oregon.

On April 25, 2005, Applicant submitted an application for medical licensure in the state of Oregon. Applicant reported that he was Board certified in psychiatry and neurology in 1978. In accordance with OAR 847-020-0170(4)(c), the applicant may be required to take and pass the SPEX examination. Applicant requested a Limited License SPEX (LLSX) which was issued on June 29, 2005, thus indicating he would take and pass the SPEX examination prior to the LLSX expiration date of December 29, 2005. Applicant did not pass the SPEX examination on two occasions: September 1, 2005 and October 18, 2005. Applicant is requesting a license limited to psychiatry.

Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (chapter 183), Oregon Revised Statutes, and fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing and any appeal there from by the signing of and entry of this Order in the Board's records.
