Licensee entered into a Stipulated Order Modifying Stipulated Order with the Board on August 3, 2006. This Order modified Licensee's January 13, 2006 Stipulated Order by holding terms 5.2 and 5.3 in abeyance and added a term that limits her practice to surgical assisting only. All other terms of Licensee's January 13, 2006 Stipulated Order remain in full force and effect.

***HUDSON, Peter Christian, MD; MD13138; CORVALLIS, OR**

Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order with the Board on August 3, 2006. In this Order, Licensee agreed to withdraw from the practice of medicine while under investigation.

STIPULATED ORDER

1.

On January 13, 2006, Judy Langdon Gilbert, MD (Licensee) entered into a Stipulated Order with the Board of Medical Examiners (Board). This Order placed Licensee on probation with certain conditions. On May 23, 2006, Licensee submitted a written request asking the Board to hold Terms 5.2 and 5.3 of this Order in abeyance under the condition that she limits her practice to surgical assisting only. Terms 5.2 and 5.3 read as follow:

- 5.2 Licensee, in a timely manner, shall enroll in and successfully complete Continuing Medical Education on patient records approved in advance by the Board's Medical Director.
- 5.3 At her own expense, Licensee shall enroll in, fully cooperate with, and successfully complete the Physicians Evaluation Education Renewal (PEER) program of the Oregon Medical Association. Licensee shall enroll in PEER within 60 days from the date this order is ratified by the Board.

A new term, Term 5.11, will be added to the January 13, 2006 Stipulated Order as follows:

5.11 Licensee shall limit her practice to surgical assisting only. Surgical assisting includes assisting in surgery only and does not include any patient care or follow-up, including prescription writing.

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
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

Having fully considered Licensee's request, the Board does hereby order that Terms 5.2 and 5.3 be held in abeyance and that Term 5.11, as stated above, be added to January 13, 2006 Stipulated Order effective the date this Order is signed by the Board Chair. All other terms of the January 13, 2006 Stipulated Order are unchanged and remain in full force and effect.

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1.

The Board of Medical Examiners (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians in the state of Oregon. Peter Christian Hudson, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state of Oregon.

2.

On June 16, 2006, the Board of Medical Examiners began an investigation into Licensee's taking and using of psychostimulant controlled substance pharmaceutical samples. Based on information obtained during the investigation, concerns were raised regarding the Licensee's ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

3.

Due to the information obtained during the investigation, Licensee and the Board agree to the entry of this Interim Stipulated Order, which provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions:

3.1 Licensee voluntarily withdraws from the practice of medicine pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

4.

At the conclusion of the Board's investigation, Licensee's status will be reviewed in an expeditious matter. If the Board determines, following the review, that Licensee shall not be permitted to return to the practice of medicine, Licensee may request a hearing to contest that decision.

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

This Order is issued by the Board pursuant to ORS 677.205 for the purpose of protecting the public and making a complete investigation in order to fully inform itself with respect to the performance or conduct of the Licensee and Licensee's ability to safety and competently practice medicine. Pursuant to ORS 677.425, Board investigative materials are confidential and shall not be subject to public disclosure, nor shall they be admissible as evidence in any judicial proceeding. However, as a stipulation this order is a public document.
