**BOARD ACTION REPORT**  
**February 16, 2008 – March 15, 2008**

The information contained in this report summarizes new interim and final actions taken by the Oregon Medical Board between **February 16, 2008 – March 15, 2008**.

Scanned copies of Interim Stipulated Orders, Orders of Emergency Suspension, Stipulated Orders, Final Orders, Termination Orders, Modification Orders and Voluntary Limitations are included at the end of this report in the order that they appear in the report. These orders are marked with an \* asterisk. **Scanned copies of Corrective Action Orders are not posted as they are not disciplinary action and impose no practice limitations.** Complaint and Notices of Proposed Disciplinary Action are not listed in this report as they are not final actions by the Board. Both Orders, however, are public and are available upon request as described below.

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**\*BASKERVILLE, Mark John, MD; MD23614; Springfield, OR**

Licensee and the Board entered into an Interim Stipulated Order on March 6, 2008. In this Order Licensee agreed to withdraw from the practice of medicine pending the conclusion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine. This Order became effective on February 21, 2008, the date the Licensee signed the Order. The Board approved the Order on March 6, 2008.

**\*COWAN, CHRISTOPHER LEE, MD; MD22737; CAMAS, WA**

Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order with the Board on March 6, 2008. In this Order Licensee agreed to withdraw from the practice of medicine pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his competency to practice medicine. This order became effective on March 4, 2008, the date Licensee signed the Order. The Board approved the Order on March 6, 2008.

**HUNTLEY, Sonia, MD; MD17343; Portland, OR**

On March 6, 2008 the Board issued an Order Terminating Corrective Action Order. This Order terminated Licensee's January 11, 2007 Corrective Action Order.

**\*STUBBS, ERVIN GENE, MD; MD07745; Oregon City, OR**

Licensee entered into a Voluntary Limitation with the Board on March 6, 2008. In this Order the Board agreed to reactivate Licensee's Oregon medical license under the condition that he limit his practice to clinical autism research only. This Order is not a disciplinary action.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the state of Oregon. Mark John Baskerville, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state of Oregon.

2.

The Board has opened an investigation after receiving a report that raises serious questions in regard to Licensee's ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

3.

Due to the above described report and the need to protect the public, Licensee and the Board agree to the entry of this Interim Stipulated Order, which provides that Licensee shall comply with all of the following conditions:

- 3.1 Licensee voluntarily withdraws from the practice of medicine pending completion of the Board's investigation of this matter.
- 3.2 Failure to comply with this Order will violate ORS 677.190(18) and may result in disciplinary action by the Board and an Order for Emergency Suspension.
- 3.3 Licensee agrees to sign all necessary releases so that the Board will have full and unrestricted access to copies of his records and reports involving his medical care, treatment, evaluations and follow-up.

At the conclusion of the Board's investigation, Licensee's status will be reviewed in an expeditious manner. If the Board determines, following that review, that Licensee should not be permitted to return to the practice of medicine, Licensee may request a hearing to contest that decision.



This order is issued by the Board pursuant to ORS 677.420(1) for the purpose of making a complete investigation in order to fully inform itself with respect to the performance or conduct of the Licensee and Licensee's ability to safety and competently practice medicine. Pursuant to ORS 677.425, Board investigative materials are confidential and shall not be subject to public disclosure, nor shall they be admissible as evidence in any judicial proceeding. However, as a stipulation, this order is a public document.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the state of Oregon. Christopher Lee Cowan, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state of Oregon.

2.

On March 6, 2007, the Oregon Medical Board began an investigation of Licensee after receiving information involving a history of substance abuse problems. Based on this notification and new information obtained by the Board on March 4, 2008, the Board has concerns about the Licensee's ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

3.

In order to address the concerns of the Board, Licensee and the Board agree to the entry of this Interim Stipulated Order, which provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions:

3.1 Licensee voluntarily withdraws from the practice of medicine and his license is placed in Inactive status pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

3.2 Licensee understands that violating any term of this Order will be grounds for disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(18).

3.3 This Order becomes effective the date it is signed by Licensee.

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At the conclusion of the Board's investigation, Licensee's status will be reviewed in an expeditious manner. If the Board determines, following that review, that Licensee shall not be permitted to return to the practice of medicine, Licensee may request a hearing to contest that decision.


