**BOARD ACTION REPORT**  
**June 15, 2015**

The information contained in this report summarizes new, interim, and final actions taken by the Oregon Medical Board between May 16, 2015, and June 15, 2015.

These orders are marked with an \* asterisk. **Scanned copies of Consent Agreements are not posted, as they are not disciplinary action and impose no practice limitations.** Complaint and Notices of Proposed Disciplinary Action are not listed in this report, as they are not final actions by the Board. Both Orders, however, are public and are available upon request.

On May 26, 2015, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order to voluntarily cease the treatment of chronic pain with DEA scheduled medications, the treatment of addiction, and the prescribing of buprenorphine pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

On June 4, 2015, the Board issued an Order Modifying Corrective Action Agreement. This Order modifies Licensee's November 6, 2014 Corrective Action Agreement.

On June 2, 2015, Licensee entered into a Consent Agreement with the Board. In this Agreement, Licensee agreed to complete a mini-fellowship.

On June 4, 2015, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order to voluntarily withdraw from practice and place his license in Inactive status pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine. This Order holds the terms of Licensee's December 19, 2014, Interim Stipulated Order in abeyance while Licensee's medical license is at inactive status.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including osteopathic physicians, in the state of Oregon. Peter Shelby Bogard, DO (Licensee) is a licensed osteopathic physician in the state of Oregon and holds an active medical license.

2.

The Board received credible information regarding Licensee that resulted in the Board initiating an investigation. The results of the Board's investigation to date have raised concerns to the extent that the Board believes it necessary that Licensee agree to certain terms until the investigation is completed.

3.

In order to address the Board's concern, Licensee and the Board agree to the entry of this Interim Stipulated Order, which is not an admission of any wrongdoing on the part of the Licensee, and will remain in effect while this matter remains under investigation, and provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions:

3.1 Ninety (90) day from the date of this Order, Licensee must stop treating any of his chronic pain patients with any DEA scheduled medications. For the purposes of this Order, chronic pain is defined as pain that persists or progresses over a period of time greater than 30 days.

CORRECTIVE ACTION AGREEMENT

14 On November 6, 2014, Randolph Kyle Cribbs, MD (Licensee) entered into a Corrective  
15 Action Agreement with the Oregon Medical Board (Board). This Agreement placed conditions  
16 on Licensee's medical license. On May 14, 2015, Licensee submitted documentation of his  
17 successful compliance with terms 4.3 and 4.4 of this Agreement, which read:

18 4.3 *Within six months from the effective date of this Agreement, Applicant must  
19 complete 30 hours of Category I primary care CME pre-approved by the  
20 Board's Medical Director.*

21 4.4 *For a minimum of six months from the effective date of this Agreement,  
22 Applicant must practice under the supervision of a practice mentor pre-  
23 approved by the Board's Medical Director. This practice mentor must  
24 submit bi-monthly reports to the Board's Medical Director outlining  
25 Applicant's progress in his practice of medicine in a primary care setting.*

27 The Board's Medical Director has reviewed the documentation submitted by Licensee  
and has determined that Licensee has successfully complied with terms 4.3 and 4.4 of this  
Agreement. The Board terminates terms 4.3 and 4.4 of the November 6, 2014, Corrective Action  
Agreement effective the date this Order is signed by the Board Chair. All other terms of the

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1 November 6, 2014, Corrective Action Agreement are unchanged and remain in full force and  
2 effect.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the state of Oregon. Maciej Janusz Druzdzal, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state of Oregon and holds an active medical license.

2.

The Board received credible information regarding Licensee that resulted in the Board initiating an investigation. The Board issued an Interim Stipulated Order (ISO), effective December 22, 2014, which placed restrictions on Licensee's medical license. The results of the Board's investigation to date have raised concerns to the extent that the Board believes it necessary that Licensee agree to certain terms until the investigation is completed.

3.

In order to address the Board's concerns, Licensee and the Board agree to the entry of this Interim Stipulated Order, which is not an admission of any wrongdoing on the part of the Licensee, and will remain in effect while this matter remains under investigation, and provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions:

3.1 Licensee voluntarily and immediately withdraws from the practice of medicine and his license is placed in Inactive status pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

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5.

This order is issued by the Board pursuant to ORS 677.410, which grants the Board the authority to attach conditions to the license of Licensee to practice medicine. These conditions will remain in effect while the Board conducts a complete investigation in order to fully inform itself with respect to the conduct of Licensee. Pursuant to ORS 677.425, Board investigative materials are confidential and shall not be subject to public disclosure, nor shall they be admissible as evidence in any judicial proceeding. However, as a stipulation this Order is a public document and is reportable to the National Databank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.
