Dave Jones, PA-C, commented on current approval language used for physician assistants performing fluoroscopy: Current approval language states that approval is also needed from the Oregon Board of Radiologic Technology, but OBRT can only approve radiology technicians for this procedure. A physician assistant/supervising physician team can apply for an exemption through the Radiation Protection Services (a division of the Office of Environmental Public Health) in order to allow the PA to work the fluoroscopy during an injection.

Ted Ruback, PA-C, requested that the Committee receive feedback as to whether striking the entire paragraph on page 4 of the Practice Description affects the volume of questions to the Board regarding Physician Assistant core duties in hospital practices.

REVIEW APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE, CLIENT 34419

College program of client 34419 reports that client 34419 was dismissed from school, but later allowed to return, as well as awarded an "F for academic dishonesty (plagiarism)." Applicant responded "No" to Category I, Question 11: "Have you ever been restricted, suspended, terminated, requested to voluntarily resign, placed on probation, or been subject to formal disciplinary action of any kind during a medically related training program?"

NOTE: 4/13/07 – The Board denied the request of Robert Hakala, MD to act as supervising physician for Ella Clark-Nicholson and Arden Jay Gage, Jr., as Dr. Hakala’s clinic, Volunteers in Medicine (VIM), does not qualify for an exception to ORS 677.510. The Board determined that the VIM could be designated as a secondary practice site for physician assistants practicing under a different supervising physician. The Board also discussed working with the Oregon Society of Physician Assistants (OSPA) to explore options legislatively for clinics such as the VIM which would allow the clinics to operate with the volunteer efforts of more than the four physician assistants to which they are currently limited.

Client 34351 was the focus of a complaint in the state of Washington. Washington Medical Quality Assurance Commission has submitted documentation of their investigation which resulted in closure for "no cause of action."

SARVER, MD PER SUBMITTED PRACTICE DESCRIPTION WITH NO EMERGENCY DISPENSING, NO PRESCRIPTION PRIVILEGES AND THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENTS: AS MS.DEONES IS A NEW OREGON PA LICENSEE THE BOARD REQUIRED CHART REVIEW IS A MINIMUM OF 50% OF CHARTS FOR FIRST 30 DAYS, 30% FOR THE NEXT 60 DAYS, AND 20% FOR THE NEXT 90 DAYS. AFTER SIX MONTHS, REDUCE CHART REVIEW TO 10% OF CHARTS PER MONTH OR NO LESS THAN 10 CHARTS PER MONTH.

NOTE: 4/13/07 – The Board amended the aforementioned Committee recommendation as follows: Approve Gloria Elaine Deones as a physician assistant in the state of Oregon under the supervision of Patrick J. Sarver, MD per submitted practice description with Schedule II-V prescription privileges and the following amendments: All practice is approved under Direct Supervision for the first 30 days. This means that the supervising physician or designated agent must be in the facility when the physician assistant is practicing.

Chart review shall be 100% of charts for the first 30 days. At the end of 30 days, Dr. Sarver must submit a report to the Board of Medical Examiners detailing Ms. Deones' professional development. Supervision level will be reviewed once this report is received.

If a satisfactory report is received by Dr. Saver at the end of 30 days, chart review will be reduced to 50% of charts for the next 30 days, then 30% of charts for 30 more days, and 20% of charts for the following 90 days. After this six month schedule, reduce chart review to 10% of charts per month or no less than 10 charts per month.

ORS/OAR language regarding term limits for PA Advisory Committee members

Currently the language regarding term limits for members of the Physician Assistant Advisory Committee in the Oregon Revised Statutes is not consistent with the language in the Oregon Administrative Rules.

ORS 677.540 (2) reads, "The term of each member of the committee shall be for three years. A member may not serve more than two consecutive terms. A member shall serve until a successor is appointed. If a vacancy occurs, it shall be filled for the unexpired term by a person with the same qualifications as the retiring member."

OAR 847-050-0063 (2) reads, "The term of each member of the committee shall be for three years. A member shall serve until a successor is appointed. If a vacancy occurs, it shall be filled for the unexpired term by a person with the same qualifications as the retiring member."

It was moved and seconded that:

THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS AMEND OAR 847-050-0063 (2) BY ADDING "A MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE MORE THAN TWO CONSECUTIVE TERMS," TO MATCH THE LANGUAGE OF ORS 677.540 (2).

PUBLIC COMMENT SESSION

Francine Boullosa, PA-C, OSPA representative, suggested tabling the change to OAR 847-050-0063 (2), regarding term limits for Committee members, until after the outcome of Senate Bill 531 is known. This bill would change the composition of the PA Committee.

Francine Boullosa commented that administration of medication is listed in the core competency list. Requesting the supervising physician to clarify what medications a physician assistant can administer intravenously, inject or infuse, is taking the authority of making that decision away from the supervising physician.

Ted Ruback PA-C, suggested that the OSPA representative be given some time at the beginning of the Committee meeting for comments, as well as at the end of the meeting.
