THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT COMMITTEE APPROVES THE MINUTES OF THE MARCH 11, 2004, PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT COMMITTEE MEETING AS AMENDED.

Motion carried, with Randy Randolph, PA, absent.

REVIEW THE PA/PHYSICIAN REQUESTED MEDICAL AND SURGICAL PROCEDURES THAT ARE OUTSIDE OF THE CORE COMPETENCIES, AND THE LEVELS OF SUPERVISION REQUIRED *Exhibit A*

At its meeting on March 11, 2004, the Committee reviewed the 121 requested medical and surgical procedures not in the core competencies, to determine whether to add any to the core competency list on the practice description. The Committee recommended that the Board approve the proposed revisions.

At its meeting on April 16, 2004, the Board evaluated the Committee recommendations and tabled their decisions until they had more time to review the list. There are 46 procedures on the list that were of specific concern to the Board, that did not fall strictly within one of the three categories of supervision: personal supervision, direct supervision, and general supervision. As a result, six supplementary categories were added for the Board's assessment:

- 1) NAPA - Not applicable to a physician assistant
- 2) AO - Physician assistant may only assist the physician
- 3) AOPI - Physician assistant may only assist the physician, pending additional information – review by PA Committee and Board
- 4) PST - Physician assistant may perform this procedure under PERSONAL SUPERVISION in a specialty clinic or teaching facility – *pending receipt of documentation of training and letter of competency the Board may approve procedure under direct or general supervision*
- 5) DST - Physician assistant may perform this procedure only under DIRECT SUPERVISION in a specialty clinic or teaching facility
- 6) GST - Physician assistant may perform this procedure under GENERAL SUPERVISION in a specialty clinic or teaching facility

Seven of the nine physician members of the Board responded to the assessment. The Committee reviewed the Board members' preferences on levels of supervision required for PAs on specific procedures, with the understanding that the full Board had not reviewed the compiled individual member's opinions concerning the levels of supervision; therefore, it has not reached a consensus on the appropriateness of the degree of supervision for each procedure.

The Committee deferred any action to the full Board to review the list and reach a consensus.

NOTE: 7-9-04 – The Board deferred making any recommendations until the new Board members have the opportunity to review the procedures. The Board requested an additional category to reflect personal supervision in a specialty clinic or teaching facility – pending approval of documentation of training and letter of competency may approve procedure under direct supervision, but not general supervision.

REVIEW REVISED PRACTICE DESCRIPTION FORM

Exhibit B

At its meeting on March 11, 2004, the Committee reviewed proposed revisions to the current Board approved practice description form requested by Ted Ruback, PA, Oregon Society of Physician Assistants representative (OSPA).

In response to the proposals, staff made the following revisions to the Memo section of the practice description:

- “To: Supervising Physician” is revised to read, “To: Physician – Physician Assistant Team”
- Paragraph six, sentence one is revised to read, “physician assistant licensed in Oregon and initially certified by the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistant (NCCPA)”
- Delete sentence three of paragraph six

Staff made the following revisions to the body of the practice description:

- Page 1, revised “The Physician must complete the practice description” to read, “The Physician – Physician Assistant Team Must Complete the Practice Description.”
- Page 4, paragraph two, sentence one is revised in part to read, “that the Board believes all Oregon licensed, initially NCCPA certified physician assistants”
- Page 4, title of core competencies list is revised to read “THE OREGON BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS APPROVES THE FOLLOWING CORE COMPETENCY MEDICAL AND SURGICAL SERVICES FOR ALL OREGON LICENSED AND INITIALLY NCCPA CERTIFIED”

Staff suggested revising the wording of the first option under CHART REVIEW on page five. The option currently reads, “New PA Licensee, New Hire PA, or Physician Never Board Approved to Supervise a PA.” The “New PA Licensee” wording causes some confusion as to the Board’s intention. Staff suggests changing the wording from “New PA Licensee...” to read, “New Oregon PA Licensee...”

It was moved and seconded that

THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS THAT THE BOARD APPROVE THE REVISED PRACTICE DESCRIPTION FORM.

Motion carried, with Randy Randolph, PA, absent.

DISCUSS PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT SIGNING A TWO-PHYSICIAN HOLD:

The Committee discussed this issue at its meeting on March 11, 2004. The Committee agreed that the response to this request would be that a PA couldn’t sign a “two physician hold,” until such time as the Committee can further review the issue. The Committee agreed to table for further review at the June 10, 2004, PA Committee meeting.

The Committee reviewed Title 35 – Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities - Alcohol and Drug Abuse, 426.231 and 426.232, and the form “NOTICE OF MENTAL ILLNESS EMERGENCY HOSPITALIZATION BY A PHYSICIAN.”

The Committee questioned why a nurse practitioner could sign a two-physician hold, and a physician assistant cannot. Dr. Carlson pointed out that ORS 426.232 (a) reads in part, “...a qualified mental health professional, as defined by rule of the Department of Human Services...” Dr. Carlson said that in OAR 309-033-0210 (26) a qualified mental health professional meets the following minimum qualifications: Psychiatrist licensed to practice in the State of Oregon;

- a) Physician licensed to practice in the State of Oregon;
- b) Graduate degree in psychology;
- c) Graduate degree in social work – (MSW);
- d) Graduate degree in psychiatric nursing and licensed in the State of Oregon;
- e) Graduate degree in another mental health-related field; or
- f) Any other person whose education and experience meet, in the judgment of the Division, a level of competence consistent with the responsibilities required by the Division.

The Committee determined that based on the administrative rule, physician assistants are not qualified to sign a two-physician hold. Staff will send Mr. Martin a letter of explanation.

DISCUSS CONSCIOUS SEDATION

At its meeting on October 17, 2003, the Board discussed a September 16, 2003, office-based surgery accreditation presentation to the Board's Administrative Affairs Committee by Oregon Medical Association (OMA) representatives. The OMA has been working to implement an accreditation program for office-based surgery in Oregon.

At its meeting on March 11, 2004, the Committee discussed the matter of physician assistants administering conscious sedation, and agreed to obtain further guidance from the OMA in developing rules regarding approval of physician assistants to administer conscious sedation.

Currently staff states that conscious sedation can be "approved under personal supervision only in appropriate facility until documentation of training and letter of competency is received and reviewed by PA Committee."

Staff requested that in the interim, the Committee make a decision as to what is acceptable documentation of training and what is an appropriate facility.

Dr. Thiringer will request that the Board provide a definitive description of conscious sedation, necessary documentation from the PA, and what constitutes an appropriate facility.

It was moved and seconded that

THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT COMMITTEE AGREES TO GRANT CONSCIOUS SEDATION PRIVILEGES, PENDING BOARD ACTION, TO PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS PRACTICING IN A HOSPITAL ENVIRONMENT AND CERTIFIED IN CONSCIOUS SEDATION BY THAT HOSPITAL.

Motion carried, with Randy Randolph, PA, absent.

NOTE: 7-9-04 – the Board established the following criteria under which a PA could receive Board approval to perform conscious sedation:

- ***PA must receive hospital privileges***
- ***PA may only perform conscious sedation at the hospital which granted conscious sedation certification and privilege***
- ***PA may only perform conscious sedation under the direct supervision of the supervising physician or the physician's assigned agent.***

DISCUSS CHANGING THE LANGUAGE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE RULES TO ALLOW FOR THE UTILIZATION OF A PA OR PAS IN NON-MEDICAL SITES WITHOUT LISTING THESE SITES ON THE PRACTICE DESCRIPTION

At the March 11, 2004, PA Committee meeting, Ted Ruback, PA - OSPA representative, requested that the Committee discuss revising the language of the administrative rules, allowing physician assistants to practice in sites that are other than medical, without having to list these sites on the practice description or notify the Board that they are practicing at these sites.

At this time PAs are required to list all practice sites, under a specific physician, on the practice description form as stipulated in OAR 847-050-0037 (2) (a). The administrative rule does not differentiate between medical and non-medical sites.

The Committee recommended PAs notify the Board of the practice activities to be performed and the general description of the type of non-medical site at which practice activities will be performed.

The Committee deferred action, pending drafting of the appropriate administrative rule(s).

NOTE: 7-9-04 – the Board deferred decision, pending an administrative rule change. The Board questioned where the medical records resulting from the PA's practice activities at non-medical sites would be located.

DISCUSS THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PROCESS TO ALLOW PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS TO SIGN POLST FORMS (PHYSICIAN ORDERS FOR LIFE-SUSTAINING TREATMENT)

At the PA Committee meeting on March 11, 2004, Ted Ruback, PA – OSPA representative, proposed that the Committee or Board develop a process to allow physician assistants to sign the Physician Orders for Life-sustaining Treatment forms (POLST). This form specifies signature by a physician and nurse practitioner.

The Committee reviewed the POLST form, "Decade of POLST Report," and ORS 127.505 - .515 Advance Directives for Health Care. **Exhibit D**

The statute does not define whether a nurse practitioner can sign the POLST form; this apparently came from the Center for Ethics in Health Care at OHSU.

At this time, the Committee defers action to the OSPA.

It was moved and seconded that

THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS THAT THE OREGON SOCIETY OF PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS WORK TOGETHER WITH THE CENTER FOR ETHICS IN HEALTH CARE TO DETERMINE IF A CHANGE IN THE STATUTES IS NECESSARY TO ALLOW PAS TO SIGN POLST FORMS.

Motion carried, with Randy Randolph, PA, absent.

DISCUSS WHETHER PAS REQUESTING EMERGENCY DISPENSING AUTHORITY SHOULD BE SUPERVISED BY A PHYSICIAN WHO IS AN APPROVED DISPENSING PHYSICIAN

The Committee reviewed the portions of the federal regulations and Board of Medical Examiners statutes and administrative rules governing dispensing physicians in Oregon and agreed that physicians and physician assistants need to be aware of the dispensing laws. **Exhibit E**

The Committee agreed that a physician should be a dispensing physician before the physician could have a PA or a nurse practitioner dispense medication. This will require an administrative rule or rule change and revisions to the practice description.

Staff will put this new requirement in the Board of Medical Examiners newsletter, develop a new administrative rule, and revise the practice description for implementation by the next biennium. The Board will notify the Oregon Board of Nursing of the change in requirements for supervising physicians of dispensing nurse practitioners.

It was moved and seconded that

THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS THAT THE BOARD APPROVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT A PHYSICIAN SUPERVISING A PA OR NP WHO IS DISPENSING BE A DISPENSING PHYSICIAN.

Motion carried, with Randy Randolph, PA, absent.

NOTE: 7-9-04 – the Board agreed that in order for a PA to have emergency dispensing privileges, the supervising physician must have dispensing authority.

DISCUSS STAFF SUGGESTION TO ADD NEW APPLICANTS WITHOUT ADVERSE INFORMATION TO THE CONSENT AGENDA **Exhibit F**

The majority of the applicants for licensure do not have derogatory information on their application, do not request additional medical and surgical services on the practice description, and have supervising physicians who have never received Board discipline.

When preparing the agenda books for Committee review, staff copies the applicant's application form, practice description, database report, creates a summary sheet, and puts this information into a TAB. On the average, the Committee has 40 to 50 tabs to review at each Committee meeting.

Staff recommended changing the current process for new applicants without adverse information, to one that is similar to a consent agenda. A new licensee consent agenda would be a single tab that contains only a summary sheet, which would include all the pertinent information from the application and practice description.

It was moved and seconded that

THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS THAT THE BOARD APPROVE ADDING NEW LICENSEES WITHOUT DEROGATORY OR QUESTIONABLE INFORMATION TO THE CONSENT AGENDA.

Motion carried, with Randy Randolph, PA, absent.

NOTE: 7-9-04 – the Board accepted the Committee's recommendations as amended.
