DISCUSS LICENSURE STATUS OF PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS CALLED TO ACTIVE MILITARY OR PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE

The Committee provided input regarding the Administrative Affairs Committee's First Review of OAR 847-008-0055(5) as it relates to the Committee's request from the last meeting that the process for licensed physician assistant re-entry into Oregon medical practice be streamlined as much as possible upon return from military or federal service.

Dana Gray, PA-C, noted that requiring copies of discharge from Active duty, as stated the First Review of OAR 847-008-0055 (5)(c), for re-entry would not work for military personnel who had not been discharged, but only reached an end of deployment.

Staff noted this fact and will affect the change appropriately.

REVIEW EXPRESS LICENSING PLAN FOR PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS

Elizabeth Jean Dietrich, PA, has only practiced as registered nurse since 6/30/03 to present and has not practiced as a physician assistant since 8/30/02. Ms. Dietrich submits documentation of 116.55 Category I continuing medical education (CME) hours.

PRESENTATION BY ELIZABETH VANDERVEER, MD, AND JULIENE BURGESS BOTTOM, PA, ADDITION OF AESTHETIC PROCEDURES TO PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT PRACTICE DESCRIPTIONS

Dr. VanderVeer stated that she is the owner and Medical Director of the VanderVeer Center, founded in 2005, a practice limited to Aesthetic Medicine. Amongst other credentials, she stated that she is a 1998 graduate of Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU) School of Medicine, served her Internal Medicine residency at Providence St. Vincent Medical Center, and became Board Certified in Internal Medicine in 2002.

Dr. VanderVeer has had over 80 hours of CME in past 18 months including one-on-one seminars with nation's leading providers of Botox®, Restylane®, and Meso-Lipotherapy. She is certified by, and member of, the North American Society of Meso-Lipotherapy. Meso-Lipotherapy was pioneered in 1995 by Patricia Rittes, MD, Board Certified Dermatologist, as an alternative to surgical treatment of under eye fat pads and is used for spot fat removal and cellulite reduction.

Dr. VanderVeer stated that she is Oregon's leading provider of Botox® and is the West Coast's leading provider of Meso-Lipotherapy, performing thousands of injections without complications. She performs hundreds of Restylane (R) injections without complications.

Dr. VanderVeer stated that Julienne Bottom, PA, a 2005 OHSU PA Program graduate, has a Master of Science, Clinical Nutrition – 1981, 18 yrs experience in clinical nutrition in pediatric oncology, internal medicine and preventive medicine; 23 yrs experience in clinical research settings with over 12 publications in peer-reviewed journals and books. Dr. VanderVeer presents the following as Ms. Bottom's pertinent clinical training and competency:

- 25 Meso-Lipotherapy procedures performed under with Dr. VanderVeer's Personal Supervision and 74 under Direct Supervision
- 10 Restylane under 13 Botox procedures under Dr. VanderVeer's Personal Supervision
- 10 Restylane and 30 Botox procedures under Direct Supervision
- Ms. Bottom has documented 4 hours of Botox and Fillers Class (the current Board requirement is eight hours) and 15 CME hours in Meso-Lipotherapy, some with Dr. Rittes

BOTTOM, PA, PER SUBMITTED PRACTICE DESCRIPTION WITH SCHEDULE II-V PRESCRIPTION PRIVILEGES AND THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENTS: SCLEROTHERAPY; BOTOX INJECTIONS ON THE FACE ONLY, FOR COSMETIC PURPOSES ONLY; RESTYLANE INJECTIONS AND FILLER ON THE FACE ONLY, FOR COSMETIC PURPOSES ONLY UNDER GENERAL SUPERVISION. Gina Marie Glaubke, PA, has not practiced as a physician assistant or in any health care setting since 3/16/99. Ms. Glaubke submits documentation of 264 Category I CME hours.

REVIEW APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE LORI LYNNE ISMACH, PA/CLIENT 33650

Lori Lynne Ismach, PA, has not practiced as a physician assistant or in any health care setting since 5/31/04. Ms. Ismach submits documentation of 60 Category I CME hours.

Ms. Ismach is applying for licensure with a Practice Description submitted by Edmundo Rosales, MD, at the Essential Health Clinic. This is the only Practice Description that she submits at this time.

July 12, 2002, the Board made the following decision regarding approval of Practice Descriptions submitted by the Essential Health Clinic: *the supervising physician is a secondary supervising physician or the Essential Health Clinic is being added as a secondary practice location under the current primary supervising physician.*

Due to the July 2002 decision, the Physician Assistant Advisory Committee cannot make a recommendation about licensure at this time because Dr. Rosales at the Essential Health Clinic cannot act as a primary supervisor.

The Physician Assistant Advisory Committee would recommend Ms. Ismach for limited licensure given the submission of the appropriate CME if a supervising physician, other than Dr. Rosales at the Essential Health Clinic, were to submit a Practice Description, thus requesting to act as her primary supervising physician.

It was decided that, as the two year term limit set forth in ORS 677.540 (2) was enacted in the middle of Mr. Gray's and Mr. Purkerson's previous terms, they would be eligible to serve one more term.

Mr. Purkerson indicated that he was interested in serving another term.

Mr. Gray stated that OSPA had not yet asked, nor had he decided, if he would pursue another term.
