**DISCUSSION ITEM: IS AN ADMINISTRATIVE RULE NEEDED FOR MULTIPLE FAILURES OF PANCE?**

Ted Ruback, PA-C stated that the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants (NCCPA) rules stipulate that a physician assistant can take the national certification exam every 90 days, no more than three times in a given year, up to six times over six years. If the exam is not passed within six attempts or six years, the physician assistant is no longer eligible for certification.

The Committee would like to review any applicants prior to licensure who have failed the NCCPA exam three times or more, these applicants would not be eligible for express licensing. The Committee members agreed that an administrative rule should be adopted concerning multiple failures of the NCCPA exam and that it should mirror the rules of the NCCPA.

**NOTE: 7/13/07 – The Board requested statistical information regarding the passing rates for physician assistants sitting for this national exam.**

**ACTION PLAN: Draft administrative rule addressing multiple failures of the NCCPA national certification exam. Per Board request, obtain statistical information from the NCCPA regarding passing rates of national exam.**

The first, SB531 will increase the number of physician assistants on the Advisory Committee by two, and will eliminate the pharmacist position. The Oregon Society of Physician Assistants will nominate candidates, and the Oregon Medical Board will make the appointments. This will be effective January 1, 2008. The second, SB678 authorizes the status of agent in the statutes. SB717, Scope of Practice, has not yet been voted on by the House.

HB2756, worker's compensation legislation, passed.

A bill allowing physician assistants to sign off on disabled hunting licenses passed.
