Botox injectables is revised to read "Botox injections and filler on the face only, for cosmetic purposes only" and is approved under Personal Supervision.

The supervising physician has presented the Board with documentation that the PA has observed 10 and performed at least 10 Botox injections and filler procedures under Personal Supervision and that both practitioners have attended at least 8-hours of trainings.

Laser and Sclerotherapy are approved under Personal Supervision.

Restylane and Radiesse fillers are revised to read "Restylane and Radiesse injections and filler on the face only, for cosmetic purposes only" and are approved under Personal Supervision. The supervising physician must present the Board with documentation that the PA has observed at least 10 and performed at least 10 each of Restylane and Radiesse injections and filler procedures under Personal Supervision and that both the supervising physician and the PA have attended a full-day (8-hour) training on both Restylane and Radiesse for consideration to receive Board approval to perform the procedure(s) under supervision other than Personal.

THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT MAY ALSO INITIATE ORDERS IF HE OR SHE MAKES A DETERMINATION OF NEED NOT ADDRESSED BY THE PHYSICIAN’S VERBAL OR STANDING ORDER AND THE PHYSICIAN WILL FOLLOW-UP BY CO-SIGNING THE ORDER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BY-LAWS OF THE INSTITUTION.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Francine Boullosa, PA-C, addressed the Committee with the following statements:

- The current chart review standard for experienced physician assistants and supervising physicians entering into new relationships was too strict
- It was critical that the Physician Assistant Advisory Committee Chairperson be a physician assistant
- The core competency list on page four was very helpful to physician assistant/physician teams
- The process for a physician assistant to move from Personal to Direct or General Supervision should be thoroughly explained to supervising physicians when they request additional medical and surgical procedures to be added to the Practice Description
