**Legislative Update – SB531 AND SB678**

Diana Dolstra, Licensing Department Manager reported that Senate Bill 531 has been signed by the Governor, and will be effective January 1, 2008. This will rearrange the Physician Assistant Committee by eliminating the pharmacist member and adding another physician assistant. The original bill called for two new physician assistant members to the committee. The Board will request nominations from the OSPA and include the vacancy in the next newsletter as well as post the position on the Board's website. Senate Bill 678, which authorizes the status of agent in the Oregon Revised Statutes, was also signed.

Dave Jones, PA-C, noted that the departure of the pharmacy member, Darrel Purkerson, RPh, will create a need to fill the vacancy of the committee chair.

**ACTION PLAN: Add the selection of a new Committee chair to the December 13, 2007 Physician Assistant Committee agenda.**

### **Public Comment Session**

Francine Boullosa, PA-C, OSPA representative, addressed the Committee with the following:

- An inquiry as to what the provision will be for public distribution of the procedures and approval list prior to any adoption of a policy regarding these lists.
- The Practice Description form no longer lists the option under Chart Review that 10 charts per month will be reviewed, which represents a change from prior Practice Description forms.
- As physician assistants may migrate into different specialty settings and there is no board certification available for physician assistants as with physicians, the Board should be cautious when making lists of core procedures for physician assistants by specialties.
- An inquiry as to how a hospital can credential a physician assistant for a procedure that the Board has not yet given the physician assistant permission to perform, and will this become more of an issue in the future.
- Concern that requests for further documentation of experience be consistent, and that requests for specific numbers of procedures may be a hardship for physician assistants who work only part-time with a physician.
- Oregon Statutes state that physical presence of supervising physician is not necessary.

Ted Ruback, PA-C, agreed that there is a need to achieve consistency among specialties with approvals for physician assistants.

Nathalie Johnson, MD, commented that requests for further documentation of a physician assistant's proficiency in procedures stems from the Board's mission to protect the public.
