## **PUBLIC MEETING LAW**

– Warren Foote, JD, The Board of Medical Examiners Legal Advisor, Oregon Department of Justice

Mr. Foote addressed the Committee about the requirements of being a public official as a Committee member.

Public meeting law requires a Committee member excuse her or his self from Committee proceedings when she or he has a conflict of interest.

A conflict of interest occurs when a public official's personal contact creates a likelihood that the official has a bias or prejudice. Conflict of interest also occurs when the official has a financial interest in the proceedings whether through direct or indirect personal gain. Mr. Foote explained that the demise of a competitor would indirectly constitute a conflict of interest.

When a public official has a conflict of interest, she or he should announce it and then leave the room even if the other Committee members do not agree that there is a conflict of interest. Deliberations should proceed with remaining members. The meeting minutes should reflect the announcement, departure, and deliberation.

Mr. Foote expressed that a good test for determining a conflict of interest is if the official knows a person so well that she or he has a fixed perception that would interfere with judging the situation without bias. Mr. Foote acknowledged that conflicts of interest were not always clearly identifiable. He stated that he would be available to the Committee should clarification about a specific issue be required.

Confidential information about a licensee or applicant must be discussed in Executive Session and all other information must be discussed in Public Session.

A member of the public can attend public session. Only legislators and the press are allowed to attend Executive Session.

Public attendance does not mean public participation in deliberations. The Committee may determine the manner in which a public member may speak, if at all, and may solicit the expertise of various public members in a fair manner if the Committee finds that those stakeholders' will have valuable information to contribute to the decision making process.

## **REVIEW REQUEST TO AMEND PAGE 4 OF THE PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT PRACTICE DESCRIPTION**

Dana Gray, PA-C, former Physician Assistant Committee Chair, submitted a letter requesting the Committee revisit the co-signature language written on page 4 of the Practice Description. The current language is as follows:

*The physician assistant may perform and record admission histories and physical examinations, order medications, laboratory and support services, record progress notes and discharge summaries in the patients' chart, assist the physician in the daily management of the patient, and assist in surgery. The physician assistant may initiate orders in patients' charts, which are by physician written standing order or physician verbal order, indicated as such in the chart by the physician assistant's signature and name of physician who provided the order. The physician assistant may also initiate orders if he or she makes a determination of need not addressed by the physician's verbal or standing order and the physician will follow-up by co-signing the order in accordance with the by-laws of the institution.*
