

State Response to a Disaster

- ◆ **401.015 Statement of policy and purpose.** (1) The general purpose of ORS 401.015 to 401.105, 401.260 to 401.325 and 401.355 to 401.580 is to reduce the vulnerability of the State of Oregon to loss of life, injury to persons or property and human suffering and financial loss resulting from emergencies, and to provide for recovery and relief assistance for the victims of such occurrences.
- ◆ (2) It is declared to be the policy and intent of the Legislative Assembly that preparations for emergencies and governmental responsibility for responding to emergencies be placed at the local government level. The state shall prepare for emergencies, but shall not assume authority or responsibility for responding to such an event unless the appropriate response is beyond the capability of the city and county in which it occurs, the city or county fails to act, or the emergency involves two or more counties. **1983 c. 586 §1]**



State Response to Disaster

- ◆ City or county fails to act
- ◆ Emergency involves two or more counties
- ◆ A major disaster is imminent or strikes a wide area of the state
- ◆ Appropriate response is beyond the capability of the city and county



State Emergency Coordination Center (ECC)

- ◆ Located at Oregon Emergency Management
- ◆ Activated during disasters
- ◆ Staffed by OEM and State Agencies
- ◆ Provides information, direction, and coordination
- ◆ Assigns state resources
- ◆ FEMA liaison
- ◆ OpsCenter – Web-based Crisis Management Tool

OEM's Role During a Disaster

- ◆ ASSISTS LOCAL GOVERNMENTS WITH DECLARATION PROCESS
- ◆ COORDINATES THE ALLOCATION OF STATE RESOURCES TO COUNTIES
- ◆ ESTABLISHES STATE LIAISON WITH AFFECTED JURISDICTIONS



How we get a Public Assistance Declaration(usually)



Disaster Strikes

Step 1.



Initial Damage Assessment (IDA) Report damages to Local Emergency Manager (EM).

Step 2.



Local county EM compiles all IDAs and submits to OEM. OEM reviews, and makes recommendation to Governor.

Step 3.

Governor request Federal Assistance

Step 4.



Preliminary Damage Assessment (PDA) is a Joint FEMA/State effort to evaluate damage with local representatives.

Step 5.



FEMA reviews PDA evaluating **Severity, Magnitude,** and **Impact.** FEMA makes recommendation to President.

Step 6.

DECLARATION



OEM's Role During a Disaster

(continued)

- ◆ PREPARES THE GOVERNOR'S DISASTER DECLARATION
- ◆ PREPARES THE GOVERNOR'S REQUEST FOR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE
- ◆ COORDINATES THE DELIVERY OF FEDERAL RESOURCES



OEM's Role During a Disaster

(continued)

- ◆ ADMINISTER THE INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
- ◆ DELIVERS THE PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
- ◆ WORKS WITH VOLUNTEER AGENCIES IN THE DELIVERY OF DISASTER RELIEF



Actions After a Declaration

- ◆ FEMA/State Agreement
- ◆ Appointment of Federal and State Coordinating Officers
- ◆ Opening a Joint Field Office
- ◆ Implementation of Disaster Relief Programs



Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)

- ◆ Ties to other Federal agencies and resources
- ◆ National Response Framework
 - Guides federal response
- ◆ Technical and Financial Assistance
- ◆ Authority - P.L. 93-288, as amended
 - Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief Act




