**Directions From South (Medford)  
Interstate-5 to 525 Anderson Ave, Coos Bay**

- \* Take I-5 North towards GRANTS PASS.
- \* Take EXIT 119 toward OR-99 S/WINSTON/OR-42 W/COOS BAY and Merge onto COOS BAY-ROSEBURG HWY for 3 miles.
- \* Turn RIGHT onto NW DOUGLAS BLVD/COOS BAY-ROSEBURG HWY/OR-42. Continue to follow COOS BAY-ROSEBURG HWY/OR-42 for 58.3 miles
- \* Stay STRAIGHT to go onto W MAIN ST/OR-42S. Continue to follow OR-42S for .4 miles
- \* Stay STRAIGHT to merge onto COQUILLE-BANDON HWY. and follow for .9 miles.
- \* COQUILLE-BANDON HWY becomes OR-42 W/COOS BAY-ROSEBURG HWY. for 10 miles.
- \* Turn right onto Hwy 101, follow for 5.7 miles.
- \* Turn LEFT onto ELROD AVE and follow for .3 miles.
- \* Turn RIGHT onto S 6TH ST and follow for .2 miles.
- \* Turn RIGHT onto ANDERSON AVE/EMPIRE-COOS BAY HWY.
- \* Head to the far side of the parking lot and find a space.
- \* A sign will be posted directing you to the large meeting room.

**Directions From North (Troutdale, Hood River)  
Interstate-84 to 525 Anderson Ave, Coos Bay**

- \* From I-84 merge onto I-5 S via the exit on the LEFT toward SALEM/BEAVERTON. Follow for 140 miles.
- \* Merge onto UMPQUA HWY/OR-38/OR-99 via EXIT 162 toward DRAIN/ELKTON for 6.6 miles.
- \* Turn RIGHT onto W B AVE/OR-38/OR-99/UMPQUA HWY. Continue to follow OR-38/UMPQUA HWY for 50.2 miles.
- \* Turn LEFT onto HIGHWAY AVE/US-101/OREGON COAST HWY/WINCHESTER AVE. Continue to follow US-101 S/OREGON COAST HWY for 26.7 miles
- \* Turn RIGHT onto W COMMERCIAL AVE/EMPIRE-COOS BAY HWY and follow for .3 miles.
- \* Turn LEFT onto N 7TH ST/EMPIRE-COOS BAY HWY. Continue to follow N 7TH ST, follow for .1 miles.
- \* Turn LEFT onto ANDERSON AVE/EMPIRE-COOS BAY HWY, follow for .1 miles.
- \* Head to the far side of the parking lot and find a space.
- \* A sign will be posted directing you to the large meeting Room.
