\* Other options to this intersections: Riders traveling southbound can ride east on Highway 34 for 1.8 miles to use the pedestrian crossing light at Peoria Road. Northbound riders have the option to turn on Tangent Road, 2 miles south of Highway 34, then turn left on Highway 99 to use the bicycle accessible underpass beneath Highway 34. Highway 99 does have bike lanes, but is not as scenic as the official bikeway.
