

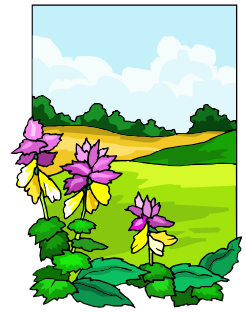

Optional Potluck/Interpretive Program:

When we get hosts together, one thing is for sure. We want to *EAT*, "break bread" and share food together while enjoying one another's company. If you'd like to arrive the afternoon before the training begins, you are welcome to arrive on-site Tuesday, April 24th (*but no sooner than 3pm, please*), stake your place to park and bring something to share. Contributions can be brought to Cascade Hall beginning at 5:30pm and the feast begins at 6:00! You are advised to bring enough to feed about 15-20 portions. Please be sure to mark your serving dishes and utensils with masking tape and your name so we can be sure they get back to you. Beverages (coffee, tea and cold drinks) will be provided. You are also encouraged to stay for an outstanding interpretive program provided by one of our interpretive park rangers, beginning at 7:00pm.

About Lodging at the Oregon Expo Center:

If you elect to stay in your RV or trailer on the Exposition Center property, you will be in a parking lot with other hosts and will NOT have utility hook-ups. If you have a serious medical condition where electrical hook-ups are required, please contact Jill directly at the phone number provided below.

Generators: You can choose to run your generator when necessary to charge your battery and run your RV while you stay on site. While we don't want to make hard and fast rules about hours to do so, out of respect for others you may be parked near and to get used to park rules, please run your generator only during the following hours: prior to 10:00pm and after 7:00am each day. Thanks!

Water: Please fill your tank prior to arrival at the Expo Center, but if you need access to more water while there, we can accommodate you.

Showers: You may elect to use your own shower or you may use those located by the Amphitheater or in the Pavillion. Please be aware that these buildings may be cold, but we'll do our best to get the heat up and running and the restrooms warmed for your comfort. Do plan to bring warm clothes, slippers and slip-on shower shoes. Hours for showers will likely be scheduled for 6:00am – 8:00am each morning, and from 6:00 – 9:00pm each night.

Dump Site: There is a dump station on the Oregon Expo Center property which you are free to use upon your departure. One of the uniformed park rangers at the site will be happy to show you its location when you're ready.
