Pursuant to a duly adopted delegation order, and acting in accordance therewith, the Director, or his designee, has approved the following actions on behalf of the Oregon Parks & Recreation Commission:

### SCENIC WATERWAYS NOTIFICATIONS

March 20, 2012, approved a Notification of Intent (2-200-12) from Hank Watson (Columbia Homes) to remove an existing home and replace it with a new manufactured home in the same location (the Deschutes River Club residence house) within the statutory boundary of the Lower Deschutes River Scenic Waterway, Wasco County.

April 12, 2012, approved a Notification of Intent (16-83-12) from David Mickey for the placement of a manufactured home within the statutory boundary of the Nestucca River Scenic Waterway, in Tillamook County. On April 5, 2012 a site visit was conducted and confirmed that the proposed home would not be visible from the center line of the Nestucca River.

April 17, 2012, approved a Notification of Intent (53-215-12) from the Portland Water Bureau to install engineered log jams on portions of Gordon and Trout Creeks within the Sandy River Scenic Waterway. The project will not be visible from the river and was found to be compatible with existing uses and necessary for resource protection.

May 8, 2012, approved a Notification of Intent from ODOT for improvements to a 325' section of Oregon State Route 138 in Douglas County within the statutory boundary of the North Umpqua River Scenic Waterway. Concrete barrier will be placed on the north side of the highway away from the river and will not be visible from the river. Its purpose is to catch falling rocks.

May 9, 2012, approved a Notification of Intent (4b-37-12) from the Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs for stream habitat enhancement within the statutory boundary of the Middle Fork John Day River Scenic Waterway, Grant County.

May 10, 2012, approved a Notification of Intent (4-192-12) from Columbia Power Cooperative (C/O Affiliated Land Services) to rebuild an existing aerial power distribution line system near Service Creek within the statutory boundary of the John Day River Scenic Waterway, Wheeler County.

## **Background:**

The Recreation Trails Advisory Committee met April 24-25, 2012 to evaluate and rank the attached list of grants for commission approval.

The Recreation Trails Grant Program (RTP) is federally funded as part of the Federal Highway Administration. Federal guidelines provide funding for motorized, non-motorized, and diverse use projects related to recreational trails.

Grant applications were solicited and OPRD received 40 qualified applications seeking funding assistance for 35 non-motorized and 5 motorized projects. This was a 12.5% increase over last year's requests. The citizen's Advisory Committee heard the presentations and based upon the program's evaluation criteria, scored the projects.

For non-motorized projects, the funds available for this round of grants are **\$1,072,545**. This will provide funding for 18 of the 35 projects. Of the **\$387,816** designated for motorized use, the Advisory Committee recommended funding for all 5 requests.

It is possible that upon final appropriation of federal funds to Oregon, more funds may be available and we will be able to assist additional grant requests.

The commission's approved projects will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration for their review and authorization.
