United States Military Registrants

United States Military Registrant means an individual who is actively serving in the Armed Forces of the United States, including the United States Army, the United States Navy, the United States Air Force, the United States Marine Corps, the United States Coast Guard, and the auxiliary corps of Red Cross workers serving with United States troops.

(1) Active United States Military Registrant - An individual registered under ORS Chapter 672 will not be required to renew an individual certification of registration as a professional engineer, professional land surveyor, professional photogrammetrist, or certificate of water right examiner while in active military service unless maintenance of an active certificate of registration is required by that individual's branch of the military, or that individual practices engineering, land surveying, photogrammetric mapping, or the professional activities of a certified water right examiner as defined in ORS Chapter 537 and OAR Chapter 690, outside of the individual's official military duties.

(a) Active military registrants will notify the Board in writing of the date they begin active military duty. The Board will not require these individuals to pay registration or certification biennial renewal fees until completion of military duty.

(b) After release from active duty under honorable conditions, these individuals will notify the Board in writing within 60 days of such discharge and no fees will be requested until the biennial renewal period following the release from active duty under honorable conditions.

(2) Inactive United States Military Registrant - Individuals registered under ORS Chapter 672 and actively serving in the Armed Forces of the United States may request to place their certification of registration as a professional engineer, professional land surveyor, professional photogrammetrist, or certificate of water right examiner on inactive status.

(a) Inactive military registrants will notify the Board in writing of the date they begin active military duty. The Board will not require these individuals to pay inactive registration or certification biennial renewal fees until completion of military duty.

(b) After release from active duty under honorable conditions, these individuals will notify the Board in writing within 60 days of such discharge and former status will be restored upon completion of, if applicable, 15 PDH units per year for each year (or part of a year) inactive, to a maximum of 30 PDH units, as written in OAR 820-010-0635. No fees will be requested until the biennial renewal period following the release from active duty under honorable conditions.

(c) Inactive United States Military registrants and certificate holders are not authorized to engage in the professional practice of engineering, land surveying, photogrammetric mapping, or the professional activities of a certified water right examiner, outside of their official military duties. Outside of their official military duties, inactive United States Military registrants and certificate holders may not hold out as professional engineers, professional land surveyors, professional photogrammetrists, or certified water right examiners.
