Current policy issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current policy uses the term 'Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner' and the initials SANE to identify the nurse who is or would be 'competent' to perform a sexual assault exam an any patient/victim. • Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) is a title (& the initials) of certification acquired by taking a state approved course followed by clinical competency validation. • A nurse that has not taken the approved course and completed the validation or a nurse that has taken the approved course without the clinical competency validation has not completed the process to be certified, thus cannot claim or use the title or initials. • The OSBN policy should reflect the SANE certification process in it's naming and content. • The OSBN policy is to clarify the practice for competency for the nurse who is performing a sexual assault examination. 	Further work to revise policy per discussion.

Follow Up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Policy title to be renamed to revise the phrase 'Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner'. • Body & content of policy to be revised to reflect the state's expected practice & competency. • Revised policy is to reflect the differences in education and clinical requirements required for the adult, adolescent, and pediatric victim. • The definition of 'competency evaluation' will need to reviewed and revised. • The revisions are to reference the syllabus &/or course outline of the state approved SANE certification course &/or the national organization's (International Association of Forensic Nurses, IAFN) scope of practice guidelines to assist in defining the educational and clinical requirements for nurses in the state of Oregon to perform a sexual assault examination for the adult, adolescent, and pediatric victim. 	<p>Obtain copy of the state approved syllabus/course outline for sexual assault training.</p> <p>Obtain copy of IAFN's Forensic Nurse Scope of Practice guidelines.</p>
