Authorized Orders for Client Care

The Law regulating the practice of nursing provides that licensed nurses accept and execute orders for client care from ~~a physician, dentist, or nurse practitioner.~~ licensed health care providers who are authorized by Oregon statute to independently diagnose and treat.

~~However,~~ O, orders from these providers may be transmitted to the nurse through the practitioner's authorized representative, who may not be a licensed health care professional. Such orders that are transmitted to the nurse through the practitioner's authorized representative or agent are to be documented and co-signed by the licensed health care providers who are authorized by Oregon statute to independently diagnose and treat following institutional/agency policies ~~physician, dentist, or nurse practitioner following institutional/agency policies.~~
