After initial interviews earlier in December, the Oregon State Marine Board (OSMB) has named the four final candidates for the State Marine Director. They are:

- Randy Henry, Boating Safety Program Manager at the Oregon State Marine Board
- Cody Jones, Boating Law Administrator and Assistant Commander, Game Warden, Texas Parks and Wildlife Department
- Gail Levario, Vice President and Strategy and Market Development with EROAD, Inc.
- Larry Warren, Enterprise Shared Services Director with the Department of Administrative Services

Second interviews will take place on January 9, 2018. Candidates will meet with members of the community, employees of OSMB and the Governor's Natural Resource staff. The final interview will be held during the board meeting scheduled for January 10, 2018. The public meeting will be hosted at the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, Commission Room at 4034 Fairview Industrial Drive SE, Salem, Oregon and will start at 9:00 a.m. The Board will meet in executive session per ORS 192.610(2)(a) to consider employment of the director.

The governing Board consists of five members, confirmed by the Senate and appointed by the Governor. The Board guides the Director in setting state boating policy and has the authority to enact rules for boat operation. All Board members are also recreational boaters.
