



## County Property Tax for Floating Property

The transfer of ownership of the floating property must be updated in the county in which the floating property resides. It is the responsibility of the seller and buyer to notify the county of the date of transfer and follow-up with the county assessor's office if no tax statement is received during the tax season. The Oregon State Marine Board sends copies of new titles to several counties in Oregon as a courtesy upon request from county tax assessor offices.

The attached form can be used to notify the county of a change in ownership. Additional forms may be required and/or available at the county regarding filings and tax deadlines. Please contact the county for more specifics. Counties listed below assess the majority of floating properties in Oregon. Check your local telephone directory listing for other county tax offices.
