The Oregon State Police is currently seeking a qualified candidate from the Central Willamette Valley, or Southern Oregon to fill a vacancy on the Oregon State Athletic Commission.

The Oregon State Athletic Commission is charged with regulating ring sports in Oregon that include Entertainment Wrestling, Professional Boxing, and Mixed Martial Arts. The Commission consists of a five member, volunteer Commission, and an Executive Director responsible for the administration of the program.

Members of the Commission are appointed to four year terms by the Superintendent of the Oregon State Police. The Commission is seeking qualified candidates that possess experience or a background that would contribute to its mission of effectively regulating ring sports.
